## I Corinthians 10 – 26 December 2021 "Do No Harm Part 3 of 3: Get Godliness"

#### **Introduction**

- \*We're in a very practical book, teaching us about:
  - -Divisions (Chapters 1-4), Disputes (Chapters 5-6)
  - -Christian marriage when ideal is lost (Chap 7)
  - -Conscience issues & Christian Liberty (Chap 8-10)
  - -Proper public worship (Chap 11-14)
  - -Doctrine of the Resurrection (Chap 15-16)
- \*Whole section (chap 8-10) has been all about how to deal with practical issues & interactions of life that arise \*Chap 8 Decide conscience issues from a place of love, knowledge and humility
- \*Chap 9 Even in issues involving our rights; live out our <u>calling of giving</u> & not expecting to receive
- \*Chap 10 The greatest thing we can do to help others is to <u>GET GODLINESS</u>
- \*Best way to help others come close to God is for you to role-model being close to God

#### \*Today 3 tools to G.E.T. Godliness

### 1<sup>st</sup> tool to G.E.T. Godliness is to Guard Yourself: Even believers can easily fall into sin (Vs 1-12)

#### Read Vs 1-4

- 1. Baptized = They were all identified together w/ Moses, his mission & his God
- 2. Notice vs 4 These things are a shadow of being identified w/ Jesus Christ
  - a. Under Cloud: They had God's presence
  - b. Passed thru sea: They had God's deliverance
  - c. Same food/drink: They had God's provision
- 3. That the water that came from the rock pictures Jesus Christ explains why it was so wrong to strike the Rock the second time! (Num 20:10)
- 4. So, opening point is 'they all came into a great chance at relationship with God thru Moses'

#### Read Vs 5-6

- 1. OT stories were written <u>for even us</u> to learn from. Even to learn practical living
- 2. God hand-picked these OT accounts for us

#### Read Vs 7-10

- 1. Specific heart-conditions to watch out for
  - a. Vs 6b Lust/greed = not satisfied w/ God
    - i. Are you satisfied in a life w/ God?
    - ii. God has a destination for you that's good!
  - b. Vs 7 Idolatry (golden calf) They made God & religion the way they wanted it to be
    - i. You willing to accept God the way He is?
  - c. Vs 8 Fornication One partner for life wasn't enough for them
  - d. Vs 9 Tempt Christ (Read Exo 17:6-7) they said, "is the Lord among us or not" b/c they didn't like their food or provision
    - i. You satisfied w/ God provision for you?
  - e. Vs 10 Murmur they longed to go back to Egypt for the leaches and onions
    - i. You satisfied with the path God has you on?

#### Read Vs 11

- 1. We should read the OT and learn, not just what to do, but what happens to those that don't
- 2. Don't let the world take away your peace in Jesus

#### Read Vs 12

- 1. The power & holiness of God should give us a respectful reverence (called the fear of the Lord)
- 2. Be humbled by what happened to OT sinners
- 3. Read Prov 4:20-23 So how do we guard ourselves? By being discipled in God's Word!

# 2<sup>nd</sup> tool to G.E.T. Godliness is to Examine Yourself: You're either moving toward God or sin (Vs 13-22)

#### Read Vs 13

- 1. All generations face same temptations of sin
- 2. There are others around you tempted by the same types of sins you're tempted by reach out
- 3. The good news ALL OF IT is conquerable thru the power of Christ Jesus in you!

#### Read Vs 14

1. Idolatry = the temptation to be discontent w/ God and change the passion of our life to another

- 2. This has many applications
  - a. Flee from false religions
  - b. Flee from false forms of Christianity
  - c. Flee from making another else your passion
  - d. In this case Paul is specifically talking about fleeing the idolatry in the pagan temples

#### Read Vs 15-17

- 1. As Israel were identified w/ Moses, we, the church, are identified w/ Jesus in the communion & fellowship of the wine & bread
- 2. Paul will address the communion service in detail in chap 11 but for now, he's making point that we're showing other we're in agreeance

#### Read Vs 18-20

- 1. Part to abstain from isn't the meat; but it's the practice having fellowship in sacrifice to false gods
- 2. Don't eat there allowing others to think you're in agreement with what they teach and believe

#### Read Vs 21

- 1. What does he mean you can't do both?
  - a. Read Matt 6:24 if you love the idol then you hate God
  - b. Believers will either listen to the Holy Spirit or they'll 'burn out the clutch', but living a double-life can only last so long

#### Read Vs 22

- 1. Trying both worlds is adultery & angers God
- 2. You're either moving towards God or moving towards sin
  - a. Like a circle w/ God's heart in the middle
    - i. There're many vectors you can go toward
    - ii. But only ONE center
    - iii. You can only be moving in one direction
- 3. Read Psm 26:2 So how do we examine ourselves? By being discipled by God thru prayer

### 3<sup>rd</sup> tool to G.E.T. Godliness is to Tighten Yourself: Honor God by avoiding even appearance of sin (Vs 23-33)

#### Read Vs 23-24

- 1. Do only those things that are profitable and things that build yourself & others up
  - a. As you would with monetary transactions
- 2. That should be our perspective toward sin its biggest problem isn't that it's wrong, but that it's harmful harmful to self and others

#### Read Vs 25-26

- 1. Meat is just meat, eat; for it's God's provision
- 2. You're not partaking in pagan rituals just b/c you bought meat from the market

#### Read Vs 27-29a

- 1. If knowledge comes that could possibly make it appear like you're a part of pagan ritual, then abstain
- 2. Avoid even the appearance of agreeing with the false religious practice others are watching

#### Read Vs 29b-30

- 1. Don't give other believers an occasion to judge the conscience issues that you allow
- 2. So, we certainly avoid sin, that just makes us a moralist, but we also avoid things that would make others think we're sinning...that makes us godly

#### Read Vs 31-32

- 1. Honor God in such a way that we're not offending people with our habits that we allow
- 2. Before every indulgence just ask, would this please my Heavenly Father?

#### Read Vs 33

- 1. Paul's geared toward trying to profit and help as many people as I can, not himself
- 2. Are we geared toward trying to profit others?
- 3. Read Gal 5:13 So how do we tighten ourselves? By serving others in fellowship

#### Conclusion

In all manner of personal practices, having the goal of personal godliness is the best way to be prepared to offer love & help to others. So how do we GET godliness?

### 1. Guard Ourselves: Even believers can easily fall into sin

- a. Many people fall into harm simply b/c they think they have what it takes to withstand sin
- b. We need God's Word to wash us daily

## 2. Examine Ourselves: Are we moving towards God or towards sin?

- a. We're putting our time/energy into pursuing the heart of God or the edge of Christianity
- b. Spend time w/ God in prayer & have Him search us and try us

# 3. Tighten Ourselves: Honor God by avoiding even the appearance of sin

- a. Are we willing to let go of this world for the greater cause of Christ & salvation?
- b. Stay tight w/ believers & experience the joy of godly fellowship
