Jeremiah 4:5 - 5:19 - 1 Dec 2013

In chapter 2 we saw all the things WE do when fleeing from God. Now, let's look at God's activity. **God will begin using these 4 progressively worsening methods to encourage us to repent.**

- 1) Vs 5-8
 - a. The 1st step God uses is He chastises us.
 - i. How did they even get here? Hezekiah was bragging about his STUFF to Babylon. (about 100 years ago)
 - ii. God's chastisement is usually just Him withholding His hand of mercy/grace and allowing us to receive what we've sown from sinful actions.
 - iii. Hard times happen for a reason. Don't waste it, learn from it.
 - iv. Read Eze 33:11, Isa 59:1-2
 - v. Example:
 - 1. Achan negative example
 - 2. David Repented at the chastisement of Nathan
 - vi. My Story:
 - 1. Raised Christian, but didn't' want it.
 - 2. Mrs. Pyne "God loves you even when you act this way".
 - 3. Kicked out of school b/c I wouldn't listen.

2) Vs 9-12

- a. The 2nd step God uses is He allows confusion and we begin to feel deceived by our confidants.
 - They had false prophets claim peace, peace was coming, but it didn't.
 - 1. They were hanging their hats on these false messages.
 - ii. When we're in sin, we'll go to just the right "Christian" that will help us feel comfortable in our sin.
 - 1. Then when we're reproved by our church, we act confused, as if it shouldn't be a problem!
 - iii. This will happen on a mass scale in the last days.
 - 1. Read I Thess 2:11 "strong delusion"
 - iv. Example:
 - 1. Aaron the High Priest "What's wrong Moses, the people wanted to worship their god, the calf."
 - v. My Story: Wendy's wanted to fire me after 8 yrs. Couldn't understand what they saw wrong with me.

3) Vs 13-22

- a. The 3rd step God uses is He begins confiscating friends, possessions and thoughts.
 - i. Friends; even those you trusted in turn on you and there's no one to support.
 - ii. Possessions; we no longer seem to get salvation or even distraction from our addictions.
 - iii. Thoughts; becomes harder to rationale/ justify our behavior.
 - iv. Example:
 - 1. Jacob running from Esau after stealing the blessing, not to mention the birthright.
 - 2. The more Jacob tried stealing things, the emptier he became, until he met God at Bethel.
 - v. My Story: B/c of my first marriage, I had to move to Maine, away from everything good I thought I had left & into a defenseless situation.

4) Vs 23-31

- a. The 4th step God uses is that He brings us to the complete end of all we trusted in.
 - i. The vulnerability that you've tried to prevent your whole life by filling life with false gods and false endeavors has caught hold of you and you're without help or friend.
 - ii. Complete end of all we trusted in but not a complete end of.....YOU. Look at vs 27
 - iii. Example:
 - 1. Samson negative example
 - 2. Prodigal Son positive example
 - iv. My Story:
 - 1. Yes my story did make it this far.
 - a. At the mercy of the court for assault
 - b. At the mercy of the court to see my daughter
 - c. At the mercy of friends to let me live with them for a time.
 - 2. At this point it can STILL go one of two ways.
 - a. I humbled myself enough to pray the Lord help me.
 - b. He restored thru an 8 person Bible Study.

5) Chapter 5:1-9

- a. Here's the good news; each person can choose to break this worsening progressive slide and return to the truth of God!
 - i. Searching for a righteous man.
 - 1. Unfortunately, the search for a righteous man in Jerusalem was even harder than in Sodom.
 - 2. Vs 2-3 3 kinds of people, them that is, them that ain't and them that think they is, but ain't. Self-deceived.
 - ii. No matter you status; rich or poor. (Read II Chr 16:9)
 - iii. You choose to return to God, when you recognize that it is His great kindness that has taken you thru these steps.
 - 1. Vs 7 Whole time, God's been giving us what we need to truly live.
 - a. When we turn to other things, God in His kindness strips them away.
 - 2. Rms 2:4; it's the kindness of God, leads to repentance.
 - iv. We are not condemned to repeat or pay for the sins of anyone else. (Eze 18:19) Choose LIFE, repent.

6) Vs 10-19 – Reiteration for emphasis

- a. vs 10 This is step #4 of coming to a complete end and being totally vulnerable.
- b. vs 11-12 This is step #2 of being confused and self-deceived.
- c. vs 13-14 Pleading with family and friends to repent?
 - i. When speaking of spiritual subjects, do we say...
 - 1. "Well in my opinion..."
 - 2. "Well God tells me in His Word that..."
 - ii. The power and authority is in God's Word.
- d. Vs 15-17 This is step #3 of having your entire defense system confiscated.
- e. vs 18-19 God is a gentleman; if you forsake Him, He won't force Himself on you.

7) You and me

- a. If you have a sin issue in your life today, what step does God have you at?
- b. Be encouraged
 - i. All are tempted and have sinned.
 - ii. Be encouraged from the example people that where cited like David, Aaron, Jacob, the Prodigal Son.

c. Take action

- i. We don't come here just to hear but to do!
- ii. When was the last time you went to a brother/sister and asked them to pray for you about a spiritual situation in your life?
- iii. Give God true repentance that is characterized with the 4 attributes we went over last week.
 - 1. Emotional
 - 2. Full of activity
 - 3. Full of truthfulness
 - 4. It's persistent
