Leviticus 11-12 –13 August 2020 "Are You Clean?"

Introduction

- Leviticus Pertaining to the Levites
- Leviticus 1-5 presented the 5 sacrificial offerings in the Law of Israel – they picture the cross of Christ
- Leviticus 6-7 we see more details to these offerings
- Leviticus 8-10 1st institution of the 1st Levitical priests
- Now Chap 11-15 show us Laws concerning purity & how to be clean
- There are times when you're ceremonially clean & can approach God, & there are times when you're not

Today we'll see 4 reasons God made a difference between clean and unclean

1st Reason God set a difference between clean & unclean is to show us how to be different than the world (Chap 11:1-23)

Read Chap 11:1-8 – *Land Animals*

- 1. Teaching of a spiritual separation w/ a physical benefit, not that the unclean are bad animals
 - a. Eagle is unclean but teaching us in other ways (We'll soar on eagle's wings)
- 2. So Israel can eat <u>land animals</u> that chew cud AND have divided hoof.
- 3. Vs 4-6 Camel, Coney & Hare chew cud but don't divide the hoof don't eat.
- 4. Vs 7-8 Pig divides the hoof but doesn't chew the cud don't eat.
- 5. Let's make some application
 - a. Chewing cud is picture of meditating on God's Word (Read Psm 1:2)
 - b. Divided hoof pictures a Christian's separate walk w/ God (Read Psm 27:11)

- c. These are spiritual pictures to teach bigger lessons, but everything the Lord does for us has good side effects.
 - i. These laws are also good for dietary reason
 - ii. If God cares this much about our bodies, how much more does He care about our mind & spirit.
- d. Notice meat <u>is</u> allowed in your diet
 - i. In last days, some will forbid eating meat
 - ii. Read I Tim 4:3

Read Chap 11:9-12 – Sea Creatures

- 1. Israel can eat <u>sea animals</u> that have fins & scales
- 2. By this principle most fish were clean
- 3. Let's make some application here
 - a. Don't settle for shell-fish/bottom-feeders
 - b. Read Eph 2:6 We're seated in heavenly places in Christ
 - c. Christians set high standards and high goals to achieve.

Read Chap 11:13-19 – *Fowls Of The Air*

- 1. Can't eat the unclean scavenger <u>birds</u> of prey
- 2. Let's make some application
 - a. Be different than those who would eat their own kind.
 - b. We don't take advantage of our own to "get ahead"

Read Chap 11:20-23

- 1. Don't eat bugs, but if you do, eat the jumping ones
- 2. John Baptist ate locusts dipped in honey
- 3. Let's make some application
 - a. Your guess is as good as mine, the Lord will have to explain this one to us in heaven

2nd Reason God set a difference between clean & unclean is to show is that contamination works in one direction (Chap 11:24-43

Read Chap 11:24-28

- 1. Carcasses were always unclean
- 2. Carcass represented death
 - a. Life can die, but death can't live again on earth
- 3. So the application here is that the unclean can contaminate the clean, but it doesn't go the other direction.
 - a. Read Haggai 2:11-14
 - b. God desires a clean people to offer praise to Him
 - c. Praise God He Himself has made provision for us to be clean to approach Him

Read Chap 11:29-31

- 1. <u>Creeping land animals</u> can't be eaten
- 2. Toad licking out west
 - a. One of the most popular is the Colorado River Toad
 - b. I have a few questions like...Who licked the 1st toad?
- 3. There ARE unclean things in this world
- 4. This world will contaminate us
- 5. We need to step up and make a separation between us and the world by the <u>Holy</u> Spirit!!
 - a. Jesus is coming....let's be ready!

Read Chap 11:32-40

- 1. Cleansing objects that touch a dead carcass
- 2. There are methods to be washed from daily sin
- 3. Jesus washed the disciple's feet

Read Chap 11:41-43

1. Can't eat snakes and bugs with many legs

<u>3rd</u> Reason God set a difference between clean & unclean is to show us how that we represent a Holy God (Chap 11:44-47

Read Chap 11:44-47

- 1. God's people have always been different
 - a. Noah brought clean/unclean animals
 - Even so for us, we're "a holy nation & peculiar people" I Pet 2:9
- 2. Are we getting closer to Him and more separate from the world?
 - a. When 2 people are in love, they are holy unto each other not noticing world around them
 - b. God wants Israel to represent holiness by being different that the world around them
- 3. What God offers us is holy. His love, joy...
 - a. So He says be holy In whatever we do
 - b. This is My beloved Son in Whom <u>I am</u> <u>already</u> well-pleased.

i. Jesus was a holy carpenter; you be a holy...

<u>4th Reason God set a difference between clean &</u> <u>unclean is to show us our flesh in inherently sinful</u> (Chap 12)

Read Chap 12:1-4 – *Male Birth*

- 1. Ritually unclean for 1 week after having a boy
 - a. Nothing morally unclean here
 - b. Can't approach God until 40 days complete
- 2. Circumcision on the 8th day
 - a. 8th day the body produces Vit K to coagulate the blood.
 - b. Today they just give a Vit K shot & do it
 - c. Still Circumcise today?
 - i. As all God's laws to Israel, there's a ritual purpose with a physical helpful side-effect
 - 1. Circumcision lower risk of infections
 - ii. Although there's no spiritual benefit to us, there's still a physical benefit side-effect from performing it.
 - d. It's pic of removing the flesh to be clean

Read Chap 12:5 – *Female Birth*

- 1. Ritually unclean 2 weeks after having a girl
 - a. Again, nothing morally unclean here
 - b. Can't go to the holy to complete 80 days
- 2. Side Effects
 - a. Not only the hygienic side-effects, but also the care and love of God to give this time
 - b. Had time to hold your child and bond

Read Chap 12:6-8

- Notice provision for the poor to bring 2 doves
 a. Jesus was raised in a poor family
- 2. Reverse order for the offerings (Burnt then Sin)
 - a. Lev 9 Consecrating Priests & people it was Sin then Burnt Offerings
 - i. Pictured dealing w/ your sin THEN you can be wholly dedicated to God
 - b. Reverse order here b/c of who's sin it is!!
 - i. Burnt shows parents whole dedication, then Sin offering for the child's Original Sin

- ii. Jesus' death on the cross made the way for all the inherited original sin to be paid for!iii. Peter in Act 10-11
 - 1. God made a way for ALL to be cleansed!
 - 2. By trusting in the Savior!

Conclusion

So these are the reason God establish a difference between clean and unclean

- 1. To show us how to be different than world
 - a. Set them apart spiritually, but also physically

2. To show us that contamination works only in one direction

- a. World will contaminate you w/ bad acts
- b. You can't contaminate them with good behavior, but you can offer them new life!
- 3. To show us that we represent a holy God
 - a. In all that we do, bring our holy God into it
- 4. To show us that our flesh is inherently sinful
 - a. Jesus paid for our intention sin & our nature
