I Corinthians 1 – 24 October 2021 "We Preach Christ Crucified"

Introduction

- *Written in 55 AD this is one of the earliest books
- *Paul was 'here' 2nd Missionary Journey (see Acts 18)
- *Corinth was 4th most populous city in known world behind only Rome, Alexandria & Antioch
- *Popular sea commerce city w/ all vices of East & West
- *This is a very practical book, teaching us about:
 - -Divisions & unity (*This is where we begin today*)
 - -Solving Christian disputes in-house
 - -Christian marriage when the ideal state is lost
 - -Conscience issues like the eating of meats
 - -Proper public worship & Doctrine of the Resurrection
- *The central of the practical issues is where we begin with keeping Jesus Christ central avoiding divisions
- *So here are 3 reasons why we, the Church, keep the emphasis on Christ Jesus & His work

1st reason we keep the emphasis on Christ is b/c He initiated His call and gifting toward us (Vs 1-9)

Read Vs 1

- 1. Paul was called to this life, he didn't choose it
- 2. Sosthenes WAS the ruler of the synagogue but has been converted to Christ

Read Vs 2

- 1. The Corinthians from this corrupt city, are drawn by God into Jesus to be separate from sin
- 2. God has called us to be saints & to a specific ministry that He reveals to each person

Read Vs 3

- 1. Typical greeting of God's grace & peace
- 2. Combines Greek (grace) & the Hebrew (peace)

Read Vs 4-6

- 1. How do we see God's grace or gifting in them?
 - a. B/c they're growing in their knowledge of Him.
 - b. This is showing they have Christ life in them

- 2. Vs 5: We're "enriched by Him" or made wealthy
 - a. God has initiated good things for us
 - b. W/o His gifts in us, we still sit in darkness

Read Vs 7-8

- 1. Gifts are graces; same word
- 2. They'll have all the gifts until the very end
 - a. Big discussion of gifts in Chap 12 & 14
 - b. They don't cease until the end
- 3. Christ's life in us is how we'll be seen as blameless on the day He comes back

Read Vs 9

- 1. God keeps us till the end not our efforts
- 2. Notice, we're called into a fellowship not a religion
 - a. Read Gal 3:1-3
 - b. Relationship w/ God isn't based on rules
 - i. It's based on the Law of Love thru the H.S.
 - ii. Stop asking if that habit is right or wrong & start asking if it will plz your heavenly Father

2nd reason we keep the emphasis on Christ is b/c man's leadership will ultimately divide (Vs 10-17)

Read Vs 10-11

- 1. Divisions, contentions, schisms
 - a. To the fleshly person, Chloe is a snitch
 - b. To the godly person, Chloe wants to fix broken relationships w/i her area of influence
- 2. Divisions on primary issue need to be resolved Read Vs 12-13
 - 1. They mistakenly placed their loyalty in a man instead of keeping it in God
 - a. Don't be opposed to denominations
 - i. They're needed to test believers I Cor 11:19
 - b. But we should be opposed to their overemphasis on what makes them different instead of the commonality of Jesus Christ
 - 2. Paul reminds that Christ did the work, no one else bought your salvation & eternal life!

Read Vs 14-17

- 1. It's clear Paul didn't link baptism w/ salvation
 - a. In 18 months of being there, he can think of only 3 people that he baptized
 - b. Baptism is the act of showing other that you've already been identified w/ Jesus in death, burial and resurrection
- 2. Paul's point here is that he served in such a way so that people didn't worship him but God
 - a. He kept the focus on Jesus & His work
- 3. Remember in Act 14 Paul & Barnabas in Lystra
 - a. They heal an impotent man
 - b. Then people think they're gods & worship
 - c. Read Act 14:15 Paul rents his clothes & says we are also men like you but we need to turn away from empty thoughts like this
- 4. If husband mows his lawn, would wife come & thank the lawnmower? No, b/c it's just the tool

3rd reason we keep the emphasis on Christ is b/c His work unites us in equality (Vs 18-31)

Read Vs 18-20

- 1. Source of true, effective salvation is only found in the teaching of what Jesus accomplished for us
- 2. Man's "calculating a plan to gain eternal life" (wisdom) has been embarrassed, by Jesus doing the work
 - a. Read Matt 11:25 Only those that humble

Read Vs 21-25

- 1. It's not the method of preaching but the substance of preaching (Christ crucified)
- 2. <u>Fleshly man</u> looks for a physical, earthly sign (*power*) or an earthly plan (*wisdom*) to earn life
- 3. <u>Spiritual man</u> sees the *power & wisdom* of God thru the cross

Read Vs 26-28

- 1. Look around! The people puffed up with earthly pride of power or pride of smarts won't accept the plan of God thru Christ crucified
- 2. It takes a certain humility that the independent struggle to grasp

Read Vs 29-31

- 1. Those that come to salvation are those that glory in Christ and don't glory in self
- 2. The ground is level at the foot of the cross
- 3. The first day in heaven won't be filled with stories of what we've done to get there
 - a. It'll be filled with the wonders of the cross and how amazing God's plan of redemption is!

Conclusion

When you're learning about a church & all they want to talk about is there denominational legacy, run!

We will keep talking about Christ Jesus and His work on the cross! Why? B/c...

1. He's initiated His call and gifting toward us

- a. God started this whole adventure calling us into relation with His Son Jesus
- b. God is the One who equips us for all things

2. Man's leadership will ultimately divide

- a. Men tend to overemphasize their preferences
- b. This leads to seeing others as the enemy

3. Jesus' work unites us in equality

- a. If salvation was thru man's efforts, plans or brilliance, there would be boasting
- b. But it's the simple applying of the activity of Jesus on the cross that is effective
- c. Those of us that have accepted Christ know the great wisdom & power of the cross!
