## Jeremiah 8:4-9:26 – 9 Mar 2014

- 1. Intro
  - a. Chapter 7-10 aka the Temple Address against false religion.
  - b.Paul: "Turn away" from those w/ a "form of godliness".
  - c. 7:1-8:3 They thought their 'lucky rabbit's foot" (temple) allowed them to have liberty to sin w/o consequence.
- 2. Read vs 4-6
  - a. They stay in the shame of sin b/c they won't admit the truth.
  - b.I want to show you 4 results of living in acceptance of God's truth.
- 3. Read vs 7-18
  - a. Vs 8-9 In case we needed a reminder; the truth we need is found in God's Word.
    - i. II Pet 1:3
  - b. 1<sup>st</sup>: Living in acceptance of God's truth will avoid unexpected judgment.
    - i. Vs 7 God does judge.
      - 1. People say, "Maybe He'll judge Hitler or murderers but not *me*." (Unbelievers)
      - 2. Whatsoever you sow that you'll reap. (Believers)
    - ii. Vs 14-18 They're so self-deceived that they aren't even protecting themselves against the coming Babylonian invasion.

- 1. They don't believe it's coming!
- 2. Even after watching Israel in the north get judged (Dan reference in vs 16)
- iii. Will Cass running drug old friends were arrested within a month of him getting saved. He wasn't there.

## c. 2<sup>nd</sup>: Living in acceptance of God's truth will avoid the pitfalls of selfishness... looking out for NUMBERO UNO!

- i. Vs 10 From great to small, we're all susceptible to greed and covetousness.
  - 1. Read I John 2:16 All these are to promote SELF!
  - 2.2 kinds of non-believers (moral and non-moral)
    - a. I John 2:16 is for the non-moral.
- ii. Vs 11-13 These verses are for the moral non-Christians. We're so wrapped up with gaining earthly peace!
  - 1. God's more concerned with...
    - a. Our holiness than our happiness.
    - b.Our character than our comfort.
    - c. Our spiritual progress than our earthly peace.
  - 2. Though our outward man perishes our inward man is being renewed day by day.
- iii. The flesh is always concerned with getting earthly stuff. Look what Christ came here to give us.
  - 1. Read John 17:6-19 esp 8, 14, 19

4. Read chap 8:19-9:11

- a. 3<sup>rd</sup>: Living in acceptance of God's truth allows us to know Him & please Him and not grieve Him.
  - i. God aches to be with us.
    - 1. "I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked would turn."
      - a. Now that He takes pleasure in!
  - ii. Look at vs 3
    - 1. Denying to live in God's truth is like denying we know HIM. This is the ultimate grief to God!
    - 2. Look at verse 6
    - 3. "Peter, Satan has desired to sift you as wheat, but I have prayed for you that your faith fail not."
    - 4. "Hey, you're one of His, for you speak as a Galileen." "I do not know the man!", says Peter.

## 5. Read vs 12-22

- a. 4<sup>th</sup>: If only the minority is living in acceptance of God's truth, they may still suffer for the majority's decisions.
  - i. Vs 20 shows this suffering passed down the generations.
  - ii. Israel lost at Ai there were probably a minority that wanted to ask God FIRST.
  - iii. The crowd yelled, "crucify Him" there were probably a minority that were yelling, "save him".
  - iv. I hit a cat in my truck the decisions of the many gave us this system that we're in of needing to drive long distances.

6. Solutions

- a. We want to be seen as those that are accepting God's truth.
  - i. Most of us know right now the things of God that we struggle to embrace.
    - 1. Setting aside sinful pleasures
    - 2. Ridding ourselves of "the gods" in our lives.
    - 3. Is God calling you to sacrifice some time to go serve or visit with someone?
  - ii. Def of wisdom: "seeing things from God's perspective."
- b.Let's embrace God's truth in every little area of life.
  - i. You know and I know the area we're talking about.
  - ii. Next....go tell someone that you're accepting God's way of seeing things.
- c. We've talked about the 4 results of accepting God's truth, but what are the means to get there?
  - i. 1<sup>st</sup>: Living in acceptance of God's truth will avoid unexpected judgment.
    - 1. Regain a healthy fear and awe for God by reading some Genesis (Noah), Exodus (Moses) or Job.
    - 2. Regain a healthy disgust for our sin. Read thru Romans especially Romans 7 about the exceeding sinfulness of sin.

- ii. 2<sup>nd</sup>: Living in acceptance of God's truth will avoid the pitfalls of selfishness... looking out for NUMBERO UNO!
  - 1. We referenced I John 2:16 now look at the solution in the very next verse.
    - a. Grasp the eternal gains of doing will of God?
  - 2. Take new small steps of faith to see God act. This builds our trust up in order to walk in His truth.
- iii. 3<sup>rd</sup>: Living in acceptance of God's truth allows us to know Him & please Him and not grieve Him.
  - 1. Read Jer 9:23-24
    - a. We quote, "Without faith it's impossible to please God."
      - i. Faith? Faith in what?
      - ii. Substitute for the word "faith", place there "accepting God's truth and God's ways".
  - 2. What is it that God delights in? (vs 24)
    - a. When we, by faith, come to know and accept and live by who He is. (John 17:3)
    - b. Hath the Lord as great a delight in burnt offering and sacrifices as with obeying the voice of the Lord? (I Sam 15:22)
- iv. 4<sup>th</sup>: If only the minority is living in acceptance of God's truth, they may still suffer for the majority's decisions.

1. President John Quincy Adams story

- a. Trying to pass a bill to end slavery with no help.
- b. Duty is ours, results are God's.
- d. Don't live in a state of denying *anything* that God says is true!
  - i. Make it right today.
  - ii. Let this be you verse for the week:
    - 1. "Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not, <u>but have</u> <u>renounced the hidden things of dishonesty</u>, not walking in craftiness, <u>nor handling the word of</u> <u>God deceitfully</u>, <u>but by manifestation of the truth</u> commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God." (II Cor 4:1-2)
