## Numbers 16-17 –3 December 2020 "Rebellion: Speaking Against Your Own Life"

#### **Introduction**

#### Read Chap 16:1-2

- 1. Korah was of Levi's son Kohath caring for the furniture. Dathan/Abiram of Reuben w/ 250 men
- 2. They were encamped very close together

#### Read Chap 16:3

- 1. Korah's accusation: Why do you get that role?
  - a. As if Moses took it & God didn't give it
  - b. Yes all are holy, but different roles
- 2. Read Jude 11
  - a. "Gainsaying" disputing in contradiction
  - b. Lined up w/ Cain & Balaam identifies the issue as a lustful greed and discontentment
  - c. What is the cure for this rebellion?
    - i. You can die in rebellion, that's no good

## Today, 4 keys for killing the spirit of rebellion

## 1<sup>st</sup> Key for killing rebellion is to Gaze on the glory of the state God has you in (Chap 16:4-35)

#### --THANKFULNESS--

#### Read Chap 16:4-7

- 1. They're wanting Moses to fall down as if dead, but he falls down in mourning!
  - a. They're bitter rebellion is from the root word *to be bitter*.
  - b. "Bitterness is like drinking poison and expecting someone else to die."
- 2. Moses doesn't defend himself, he just says, "The Lord will give us an answer for the situation between us".
  - a. When you fight for power / position, then you'll have to fight to maintain it.
  - b. When God calls you into something you didn't earn, then He'll maintain it FOR YOU.

#### Read Chap 16:8-11

- 1. Why do you despise the role God gave you?
- 2. Easy to overlook & not be grateful for blessings
- 3. There will always be someone around you with something that you desire.
  - a. This is the cure for covetousness
  - b. Read Pro 21:26 Thankfulness
    - i. Is your life characterized by taking or by giving from what God has blessed u with?

#### Read Chap 16:12-14

- 1. Dathan & Abiram's accusation: You brought us out of good Egypt to lord over us as prince
  - a. What a short memory of the evils of Egypt
  - b. The 'other thing' that you're after isn't as good as you make it out to be.
- 2. Accusation #2: You haven't brought us to land
  - a. They're impatience Instead of getting to heaven w/ little reward, God's giving us time to gain reward along the journey.

#### Read Chap 16:15

- 1. Moses life was known by giving, not taking.
- 2. He's grateful & humble to have his position

#### Read Chap 16:16-21

- 1. So, God's answer: I will consume all the rebels
- 2. We'll see in chap 17 many more people were following Korah... in the heart.

#### Read Chap 16:22

1. Moses again pleads for grace

#### Read Chap 16:23-30

- 1. Moses pronounces God's judgement by the earth opening up & warns the people to get away.
  - a. Don't fiddle around w/ rebels, but get away.
- 2. Notice vs 28 Moses' confidence is in the fact that he has done all that he's done b/c the Lord has led him into it. It doesn't depend on him.

#### Read Chap 16:31-35

- 1. Judgement by earth and fire.
  - a. Don't need to explain the miracle, just accept it as you accept Gen 1:1.
- 2. Please note; the sons of Korah didn't die, just the rebels (see Num 26:11)
  - a. God knows how to judge and to preserve.

# 2<sup>nd</sup> Key for killing rebellion is to Agree with God's approach & authority (Chap 16:36-40)

#### --HUMILITY--

#### Read Chap 16:36-40

- 1. Censers made into plates as reminder of this sin
- 2. So a tangible remember of this rebellion
  - a. A rebellion against God's appointed roles
  - b. A rebellion against the proper way to approach God
- 3. Do you have the humility to accept that God's role is higher than all of ours! He sets the rules.

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Key for killing rebellion is to Let the love of God lead you back to Him (Chap 16:41-50)

#### --LOVE--

#### Read Chap 16:41

- 1. We said in Chap 16:21 when God was going to kill them all, that there were other sympathizers... well here they are.
  - a. Notice how spiritually blind they are to the true situation...same as today.
- 2. When we think of this rebellion, we historically call it "the rebellion of Korah in the wilderness".
  - a. Truth is he was just the leader.
  - b. Many 1,000s more believed after Korah

## Read Chap 16:42-50

- 1. 14,700 people w/ this rebellion in their heart.
  - a. Just as deadly as Korah's verbal kind of rebellion.
  - b. They weren't rebels b/c of their mouth but b/c of their heart

- 2. Aaron, the priest's incense is pic of the Great Intercessor praying for us, interceding for our best
  - a. Priest is to pray for people's failings
  - b. This is a picture of the love of Jesus, our High Priest
- 3. Notice, it's not judgement of God that brings repentance, but the kindness of God (Rom 2:4)
  - a. It was the grace of God to stop the plague
  - b. It was the grace of God to remove the sinners from affecting more sin upon them.

# 4<sup>th</sup> Key for killing rebellion is to Look at the living Christ as proof that we have eternal life (Chap 17) --FAITH--

#### Read Chap 17:1-5

- 1. What was the purpose of this demonstration?
  - a. Prove God has chosen Levi for his role.

#### Read Chap 17:6-13

1. Why did God use rods and make Aaron's bud?

- a. God is showing life from non-life
- b. He's showing something helpless that become active and effective
- 2. It's pic of resurrection, the resurrection of Jesus!
  - a. Life from death, not life from mostly dead
  - b. When God pictures resurrection in the OT, He always takes something completely dead and raises it.
    - i. Lev 13 Living bird and dead bird
    - ii. Num 17 Dead tree and now living tree
- 3. Now the items in the ark are complete
  - a. Manna, Law and Aaron's rod
    - i. I see a picture of the Way, Truth & Life
    - ii. Can also be Body, Mind & Spirit
- 4. It's Jesus' life that we need! We're dead
  - a. Having faith in Jesus is what provides us the power to be active and effective.
  - b. Read Heb 12:2 Look to Jesus for life from the dead....oh it takes faith.

#### Conclusion

So we've seen how God dealt with the rebellion of the nearly 15,000 people, who's heart was set on evil That same thought can come up within us.

- 1. Show God you're thankful for the place and giftings He's given you
  - a. God has treated us so much better than our sins deserve....be thankful
- 2. Show God the humility it takes with His approach and authority
  - a. Do we allow God to bring us up AND down?
  - b. Doesn't He have the right to do as He may?
- 3. Let the love of God lead you back to Him every day and every moment
  - a. He's always reaching out a hand of love
- 4. Have the faith it takes to look to Jesus and not to yourself for confirmation of who you are
  - a. As you have the faith to serve under Jesus, you can have the confidence that He's given you life eternal.
