Chapter 10-14 is the parenthesis between the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> trumpet judgement.

Remember the parenthesis between 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> Seal was about people (144,000 & Trib Saints)...same here.

Chapter 11 – The Two Witnesses and the Temple

Chapter 12 – Israel and the Dragon

Chapter 13 – The Anti-Christ & the False Prophet

Chapter 14 – 144,000 and the everlasting gospel <u>Israelology</u> –

Chapter 12 is foundational -unless you understand God's purpose for Israel, you'll have a confused view of what the Bible is all about. Systematic Theology

- . <u>Theology proper</u> The study of the character of God
- <u>Angelology</u> The study of angels
- . <u>Biblical theology</u> The study of the bible
- . <u>Christology</u> The study of Christ
- <u>Ecclesiology</u> The study of the church
- <u>Eschatology</u> The study of the end times
- . <u>Hamartiology</u> The study of sin
- . <u>Pneumatology</u> The study of the Holy Spirit
- . <u>Soteriology</u> The study of salvation
- <u>Theological anthropology</u> The study of humanity.
   Systematic Theology misses Israel!!!

How is your Israelology? And why does it matter?

Israelology matter for these reasons:

1) Shows that God will fulfill <u>all</u> that He says.

2) Shows that there's no reason to take God's promises as anything but <u>literal</u> and <u>true</u>.

3) Shows the depth of meaning/purpose God has for each, can't just be replaced.

Review of Vs 1-2

- 1. They often rejected their very purpose, see Matt 21:33-46
- 2. What is Israel's purpose?
  - a. Bring to the world God's Word.
  - b. Bring to the world the Messiah to reign on David's throne.
  - c. Be an example to Christians (I Cor 10:6-11)
  - d. Israel's purposes aren't fulfilled until Jesus is ruling on the throne of David.

## 3. What is your purpose? What were you chosen for?

- a. General purposes
  - i. To praise God before men (I Pet 2:9)
  - ii. To have fellowship with God (I Cor 1:9)
  - iii. To produce good works (Eph 2:10)
- b. Examples
  - i. Paul was chosen....

- 1. To preach the unsearchable riches of Christ (Eph 3:7-12)
- 2. Be a minister & witness to the things he had seen to the Gentiles (Act 26:16)ii. Jesus had purpose...
  - 1. "Save Me from this hour, but *for this cause* came I into world." (Jhn 12:27)
  - 2. *"For this cause* came I into world, to bear witness of the truth." (Jhn 18:37)
- c. When was the last time you considered if you're fulfilling God's general and specific callings on your life?

Read Chapter 12 Vs 3-5

- 1. Description
  - a. Vs 3 7 heads, 10 horns
    - i. Explained in Rev 13, 17
    - ii. Lifted straight from Daniel chapter 7
  - b. Vs 4 Tail drew 1/3 part of stars of heaven to the earth.

- i. Tail drew 1/3 part of angels
  - 1. We know 3 angels by name.
    - a. Michael (Guardian of Israel)
    - b. Gabriel (Messenger for Messiah)
    - c. Lucifer (Eze 28, Isa 14)
  - 2. Vs 9 makes it clear that this 1/3 is referring to the angels.
  - 3. Dan 8:9-12
    - a. Satan's rebellion led other angels into rebellion
  - 4. Interesting Guardian angels seems to be biblical (Matt 18:10, Heb 1:14)
- ii. Could it <u>also</u> be 1/3 part of Israel deceived?
  - 1. Stars are used in vision of women.
  - 2. Israel would be multiplied as the 'Stars of Heaven', they're not the stars of heaven.
- Vs 5 Wanting to kill the Christ to thwart God's plan.

- a. Christ is the One who would rule with a 'rod of iron'. (Psm 2, Rev 2 & Rev 19)
- b. Interesting that Herod had the same idea.
- c. Christ was "caught up" unto God
  - i. Harpazo in the Greek
  - ii. Interesting that this is the same as used for the Church, the bride of Christ, in rapture.
  - iii. Christ wasn't snatched by force at the ascension.
  - iv. Seems to be the "Holy Spirit of Christ within the church" that's being snatched up to God by force.
    - 1. He who lets will let, until He be taken out of the way.
- d. Gap in time between vs 5 and 6
  - i. Between rapture and Tribulation
  - ii. Many 'gaps' in scripture
    - 1. Isa 61:1-2a
    - 2. Luke 4:18 Jesus went half way.

Read Chapter 12 Vs 6

- 1. The Abomination of Desolation
  - a. Dan 9:27 Anti-Christ breaks covenant <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> way thru Trib.
  - b. II Thes 2:3-5 Anti-Christ will sit in the temple as god.
  - c. Matt 24:15-22 When you see this, "flee to the mountains".
- 2. Flee to what mountains?
  - a. Dan 11:41 Edom, Moab and some of Ammon will escape Anti-Christs control.
  - b. Isa 16:1-4 Sela or Petra shall be their shelter. (Also Isa 26:20)
  - c. Zec 14:4-5 The Lord Himself will come gather back from their hiding.

Read Chapter 12 Vs 7-8

- 1. Satan fought Michael, not God.
  - a. Michael and Satan contended for the body of Moses in Book of Jude.
  - b. Michael was fighting against the wicked, spiritual forces in Dan 10:13
  - c. Michael is only one id'ed as an Archangeli. Jude 9, I Thess 4:16
- 2. Satan has access to heaven to accuse us (Job)
  - a. At some point, he is kicked out of heaven.

Read Chapter 12 Vs 9

- 1. Satan wants to thwart the plan of God.
  - a. Attacked Abraham's seed
  - b. Attacked David's seed
  - c. Attacked Jesus
  - d. Why does he still attack, if the cross defeated him?

- i. Wants to prevent everyone from embracing the gift of salvation. (one at a time)
- ii. Wants to prevent Israel from embracing the gift of salvation.
  - 1. Rom 11:26 all Israel shall be saved
  - Hos 5:15 during affliction they're turn to God!
  - 3. Dan 12:1 At the end, Israel *shall be delivered*.
- 2. Satan wants to deceive us.
  - a. II Thes 2:11-12
  - b. John 5:43
  - c. If we choose to reject God's truth, thenHe'll allow us to believe whatever we want tobelieve.
- Deceive G4105 planao *plan-ah'-o* to cause to roam from safety, truth or virtue. To go astray, deceive, err, seduce, wander, be out of the way.

# a. Have you wandered away from your God given purpose in life? Have you been deceived?

- b. God's mercies are new every day.
- c. Confession & repentance.

Read Chapter 12 Vs 10-11

- 1. Vs 10 He's the accuser of the brethren
  - a. The same deceiver, is then the tempter, and the accuser.
    - i. Deceives us into thinking God's way isn't good.
    - ii. Tempts us into thinking sin is good.
    - iii. Accuses us when we fall for the lie b4God.
- 2. Vs 11 We overcome by blood of the Lamb.
  - a. We are more than conquerors in Christ (Rom 8:37)
  - b. Gates of hell can't prevail against our faith in Christ.

- 3. Vs 11 We overcome by word of our testimony.
  a. "Word" or "evidence given".
  - b. If you've wandered away from God's purpose...
    - i. Give evidence with words that...
      - **1.** Your situation is what it is.
      - 2. God is who He said He is.
    - ii. Confess with your mouth (I John 1:9)
    - iii. We have an advocate with the Father.

Read Chapter 12 Vs 12-13

- 1. Satan has but a short time.
  - a. This is why the rapture is a surprise timing.
  - b. "Until fulness of the Gentiles is come in"
  - c. Counter counting down in heaven each time someone is saved.
    - i. This must freak Satan out at each salvation!
    - ii. Is Anti-Christ alive today, yes.

- 1. Satan doesn't know when the end will begin.
- 2. He needs to be ready to possess one.
- Satan will possess the Anti-Christ at this 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yr mark.
  - a. Zec 11:17 Anti-Christ wounded by sword
  - b. Rev 13:14 False Prophet causes all to worship A-C for living thru injury.
  - c. Rev 13:3 Seemingly raised back to life.
  - d. All done in the power of Satan, mocking the trinity, Father, Son and H.S.

Read Chapter 12 Vs 14-16

- 1. Israelites provided for; 40 years in wilderness.
- 2. Elijah was fed by ravens.

Read Chapter 12 Vs 17

1. 2<sup>nd</sup> half Trib horrible for all; especially for gentile believers as seen here.
