Trumpet Judgements – God's Judgement Begins

Introduction -

Discuss how chapter 7 was an interlude after 6 seals.

Read Chapter 8 Vs 1-6

- 1. **Silence for half-hour
 - a. Scroll is finally open...expectation of 'what is God going to do?'
 - i. Silence is awesome in a vast crowd!
 - b. Half-hour = a semi time/season (no time in heaven)
 - i. Hora translated often 'hour' but also season, time, eventide, day.
- 2. Voices, thunders, lightnings, earthquake

- a. Happens after seals (Rev 8:5), thunders (Rev 11:19), and bowls (Rev 16:18) but not trumpets.
- 3. This text will give us 3 facts to believe about God's judgement on people we know.
 - a. 1st fact to believe about God's judgement: Do you believe that our prayers can affect God's judgement <u>now</u>!
 - b. Prayers of the saints
 - i. Our prayers = the incense
 - ii. God's wrath = the fire that lights the incense
 - 1. Luke 12:49 Jesus came to set this fire
 - 2. Matt 10:34 Think not that I've come to bring peace, but a sword.
 - iii. When prayers for God's will, empowered by God, mix with the sin of this world a conflict happens. (Rom 8:26)

- iv. Application: When you're praying for sinners in your life, pray for a conflict/confrontation, as hard as it is.
- c. As we're shining the Holy Spirit in abundance, we'll be living out Heb 3:13.
 - i. Help others accept God's judgement on sin
 <u>now</u> by praying for them and exhorting them.
 - ii. The more you're with them, the more you'll remember to pray for them!

Intro to the Trumpets of chapter 8

- 1. These begin the heavenly judgments on the earth.
- Seal & Trumpet judgments are most likely in the 1st half of the Tribulation.
 - a. All Trumpets effect 1/3 part of something, bowls effect the whole.

i. Trumpets just announce what's coming.

- 3. Compare to Jericho in Jos 6
 - a. March around the city 7 day (7 Seals)
 - b. 7 Priests blow trumpets (7 Trumpets)
 - c. Silent until the 7th day (silence Rev 8)
 - d. 7th day, march 7 times (7 Bowls)

Read Chapter 8 Vs 7

- 1. 1st Trumpet
 - a. Hail & fire 1/3 part of trees & grass burnt up.
 - b. Many these judgments same as plagues in Egypt.
 - c. Hail & fire is 7th plague in Egypt.

Read Chapter 8 Vs 8-9

- 1. 2^{nd} Trumpet
 - a. Burning Mountain thrown into sea
 - b. 1/3 part of sea became blood.

- c. 1/3 part of creatures died.
- d. 1/3 part of ships destroyed.

Read Chapter 8 Vs 10-11

- 1. 3rd Trumpet
 - a. A star, Wormwood, falls from heaven.
 - i. Star could be a star or a fallen angel.
 - ii. Maybe no connection, but Cernobyl is the Russian word for wormwood.
 - b. 1/3 part of fresh water became 'bitter'.
 - c. Many men died of contaminated water.

Read Chapter 8 Vs 12

- 2. 4th Trumpet
 - a. 1/3 part of the sun, moon and stars are smitten.
 - b. How? In a way that 1/3 part of light doesn't shine.

Read Chapter 8 Vs 13

- 1. Announcing the 3 Great Woes
 - a. Last 3 Trumpets are the 3 Great Woes.
 - b. God's patience and mercy do not last forever for those whom do not accept Him.

2nd fact to believe about God's judgement: Do we believe that God will do away with all the wrongs thru judgement <u>in the end</u>?

- 1. Trumpet judgement after trumpet judgement declares that God will set things right.
- 2. All sin everywhere will be blotted out.
 - a. Rev 2:21 "I gave her time to repent of her [sins]."
 - b. Read Acts 17:29-31a

Conclusion -

- Just as God has His hand in control of Satan and what He allows him to do, God is working out a good end.
- 2. So today, we've seen 3 facts about God's judgement on people we know.
 - a. Do you believe that our prayers can affect God's judgement <u>now</u>!
 - b. Do we believe that God will do away with all the wrongs thru judgement *in the end*?
 - c. Do you believe that it's the kindness of God that leads people to repentance, not the judgment of God?
- 3. Don't submit to Satan, who has to be allowed to do what he does, submit to God who controls it all and has love and grace for you.
