Exodus 22-24 - 4 June 2020 "The Giving Of The Law" Part 2 of 2

Introduction

Exodus is the story of Redemption & God's salvation as seen thru the creation of the nation Israel.

Not just saved out of Egypt, but to do saved unto God

God wants them to be role-models or examples of HIM unto the whole world

To this end, He gives them His perfect Law.

1. Chap 19-21 - We saw God's Law and how it is to Lead them to Redemption

Teaches them characteristics of God

Teaches them about the Spiritual Life

2. Today in Chap 22-24 – God's Law will show us how it is to Lead them to Character for THIS life

Today, 4 Attributes to be developed b/c of God's Law

#1 – God's Law should develop in us Integrity (Chap 22:1-23:9)

Read Chap 22:1-4

- 1. First part of honesty & Integrity is property rights and ownership.
 - a. You have rights to the things you own.
 - b. If stolen, thief restores 2-5 times as much.
- 2. Vs 2-3 If thief be found breaking & entering your property at night, you have the right of lethal force defense
 - a. If during the day, it's assumed you can stop short of lethal defense

Read Chap 22:5-6

- 1. So not just stealing property but stealing your neighbor's resources.
- 2. Need integrity to obey, b/c might just blend in
 - a. Using your neighbor's internet or water
- 3. Remember: This is how Israel will be governed but they're still great principles to live by.

Read Chap 22:7-9

1. Be honest when using another man's possessions. Judges will decide if you're the thief.

Read Chap 22:10-13

1. Be willing to put your reputation on the line to defend what happened to another man's possessions while you had them. (Read Prov 22:1)

Read Chap 22:14-15

- 1. Restitution principle applies even to borrowing.
- 2. If owner was there; items are under his care.

Read Chap 22:16-17

- 1. Be honest about your commitment to her.
 - a. You whispered sweet nothings, now back them up with commitment.
 - b. Don't lie to keep what you want, then change your mind.
- 2. God's Law is the standard for what integrity looks like.

Read Chap 22:18-20

- 1. Of the Physical, Mental/Emotional, and Spiritual levels these effect the spiritual health of the nation.
 - a. Thus have a harsh course of action
 - b. Bestiality Lev 18:23 it's called confusion
 - i. An unnatural mixture of God's order
- 2. Salem Witch Trials Should we kill witches?
 - a. No, these laws were to establish a national ID that represented the Lord God.
 - b. It would be equivalent to not allowing a witch to serve in or lead the church today.

Read Chap 22:21-24

- 1. James said this is pure religion
- 2. God delights to care for the helpless

Read Chap 22:25-27

1. Don't take advantage of the poor by charging interest money, or taking what they need to live.

Read Chap 22:28

- 1. *Gods* here is judges/leaders.
- 2. Just as they shouldn't take advantage of the poor, they should respect the position of the rulers.

Read Chap 22:29-31

- 1. In offering the first part of all our possessions to God, we don't have an excuse later to lie and say, "I don't have enough for God".
- 2. The process of redemption would be used to replace the offering to God of the firstborn.

Read Chap 23:1-3

- 1. Vs 1-2 Just as you wouldn't pervert truth to gain money, don't pervert truth for popularity of the crowd.
- 2. Vs 3 Don't pervert truth b/c you pity a poor man.

Read Chap 23:4-5

1. If only helping friends, what thank have thee?

Read Chap 23:6-9

1. Don't pervert truth to gain money

#2 – God's Law should develop in us Devotion (Chap 23:10-19)

Read Chap 23:10-12

- 1. The lands Sabbath rest was also part of their welfare program for the poor.
- 2. Not holding this law would equate to the timeperiod Israel will be sent into Babylon.
- 3. These Sabbath rests taught them devotion to God, brought togetherness.

Read Chap 23:13-17

1. Obedience to Sabbaths showed devotion of their down-time, now attending the Feasts shows obedience in their up-time.

Read Chap 23:18-19

1. Leaven represents sin. No leaven=Devotion

#3 – God's Law should develop in us Patience (As they conquer the land) (Chap 23:20-33)

Read Chap 23:20-23

- 1. The angel seems to be a pre-incarnate appearance of Jesus Christ.
- 2. It takes patience to follow another's lead instead of doing what YOU think is best.

Read Chap 23:24-33

- 1. It takes patience to wait for the Lord to slowly drive out the Canaanites.
- 2. But it's for there good that it happens slowly.
- 3. Vs 32 Gibeonites would trick them into a covenant later, but they were of the land.

#4 – God's Law should develop in us Commitment (Chap 24)

Read Chap 24:1-3

1. Just as at the beginning of giving the Law (Exo 19:8) and now again at the end. The commitment.

Read Chap 24:4-8

- 1. This took great commitment
 - a. Commitment of money offer sacrifice
 - b. Commitment of time to read whole Law
 - c. Commitment of their individuality to become one together.

Read Chap 24:9-11

1. This is none other than the throne room of God as pictured on Eze 1, 10 and Rev 4.

Read Chap 24:12-18

1. So the special place Moses has in the plan of God b/c of his commitment to serving the Lord.

Conclusion

So 4 Attributes that should be developed from God's Law.

NOTE: Though we're not under the burden of keeping the Law, we're still guided by the Holy Spirit that leads us into the *same perfect principles*.

- 1. Integrity Do you have an honesty about all your transactions with people?
- 2. **Devotion** Do you have markers or traditions in your life (like feasts) that show your devotion to the Lord?
- **3. Patience** Do you agree that you're getting God's best when He gives you success lowly?
- **4. Commitment** Have you committed your time, money and individuality to the Lord?
