"Applying Our Righteousness To Government" Introduction

- *Paul wrote Romans as best document on salvation!!
- *Rom 1-8 describes our natural unrighteousness & the solution of believing the cross of Christ has paid our way into a right relationship with God
- *Chap 9-11 Paul turns to chronologically look at Israel
- *Rom 12-end -applying righteousness to all of life

Romans 6:4 – "As Christ was raised up from the dead... even so we also should walk in newness of life." But how?

Rom 12 showed us how to apply our new righteousness to <u>ourselves</u>, the <u>church</u> & the <u>world</u>

We apply our righteousness to govt by being subject to their authority

Today, Romans 13 we'll see 4 reasons to be subject to governmental rulers

#1 – We should be subject to govt rulers b/c they can execute wrath (Vs 1-4)

Read Vs 1

- 1. First, the injunction to accept their authority
 - a. Do we generally accept their right over us?
 - b. Or Do we generally grumble & complain?
- 2. Second, the reason we accept their authority is b/c God has allowed them to rule.
 - a. You mean God allowed Hitler to rule?
 - i. Yes, for 12 years, God allowed that evil
 - ii. That time also moved nations to allow Israel to be re-born as a nation fulfilling prophecy
 - b. God know how to use sin sinlessly to accomplish His will

Read Vs 2

- 1. God's isn't endorsing a certain form of govt, but the principle of govt's power to rule people
- 2. You're resisting authority that God established & they will 'make a decision against you'

Read Vs 3-4

- 1. Rulers main job is to keep good order & disciple, they rightfully have power to punish.
 - a. Read Heb 13:17 Rules supposed to help u
- 2. Good vs bad
 - a. If you live at peace, rulers should be happy
 - b. If you are acting evil, ruler should punish u
- 3. You know that rulers have become evil when they become a terror to the peacemakers.
- 4. You know that rulers have become evil when they turn people from good works, like sharing Gospel
 - a. Govt is to prevent evil but we live in an age that govt wants to disobey the good will of God
 - b. Read Isa 5:20 those that call evil good

#2 – We should be subject to govt rulers b/c it's the right moral thing to do (Vs 5-7)

Read Vs 5

- 1. Conscience: awareness inside to do right thing
- 2. Respecting authority is the right thing to do

Read Vs 6

- 1. The job the govt does, does cost money
- 2. Read Luk 20:22-25 So, pay your taxes, it is the right moral thing (give **image** punchline later)
 - a. Even if you think it's too much
 - i. That's an opinion or policy matter not a violation of God's Word or moral standards

Read Vs 7

- 1. Obey all levels of govt authority & cheerfully
- 2. Govt does things we don't 'like', but that aren't morally wrong according to the Bible. Obey them
- 3. I Pet 2:17-19 endure thru hard laws imposed
- 4. I Tim 4:2 Possible to sear your conscience

#3 – We should be subject to govt rulers b/c we should love people (Vs 8-10)

Read Vs 8

- 1. Don't hold back something that is morally due to be given.
- 2. WHAT THIS DOESN'T MEAN Don't have a mortgage or loan
 - i. Read Matt 5:42 Any of us could fall into need from time to time

Read Vs 9-10

- 1. In each & every case, you've taken something that belongs to them & now you're in debt to them
 - a. You've taken from them instead of giving to them
 - b. Give others good things, don't take their good things
- 2. Read Matt 22:37-40
 - a. Law was meant to show us how to love
 - b. The way to obey rulers is to love

#4 – We should be subject to govt rulers so we can get on with the Gospel (Vs 11-14)

Read Vs 11-12

- 1. Time is short, so take the Gospel-life serious
 - a. We lull ourselves into thinking we have forever, but we don't know how long.
 - b. We DO know that we have less days before we see God than when we first believed.
 - c. Is God calling you?
 - i. Are you being called to quit a sin? Do it!
 - ii. Are you being called to love the unlovable?

 Do it now!
 - iii. Are you being called to start a work? Do it!
- 2. The connection between this point and our submission to rulers is this:
 - a. Make our relation with the world a nonissue so we can get to the business of spreading the Gospel to the whole world.
 - b. Same as our relationship w/ money (Pro 30)

Read Vs 13-14

- 1. Don't waste time in partying, but be sober
- 2. Do right by the govt, so that we can be about our Father's business
 - a. Read I Tim 2:2 quiet & peaceable life
 - b. Remember Reading Luke 20:22-25 earlier?
 - i. Punchline God's image is on you, so "carry" it properly
- 3. There IS a time to disobey Read Acts 5:29
 - a. The time to disobey govt is when they're preventing you from exercising the Gospel
 - b. What is the essential Gospel?
 - i. Discipleship in the Word
 - ii. Fellowship, Communion
 - iii. Baptism, the Lord commands meetings w/ touching in many cases (Heb 10:23-25 & Jame5:14)
 - iv. Meeting new people to evangelize

Conclusion

We need to apply our righteousness to the way we look at govt. God would tell us to submit to their authority...but why?

1. B/c they can execute wrath

- a. Think of the alternative, we should be grateful when govt punishes evil doers
- b. If for no other reason, obey so not punished

2. B/c it's the right moral thing to do

a. Even our conscience tells us that the human evil heart needs a governor on it

3. B/c we should love people

- a. You're either loving people or robbing people.
- b. Lawbreakers will get justice from rulers
- c. Peacemakers will be left alone

4. So we can get on with the Gospel

- a. Give the govt everything they ask for, up to the limit of disobeying God
- b. Pray the govt becomes a non-issue so we can be spreading the Gospel unhindered
