## Romans 4 – 20 December 2020 "The Trap Of Misplaced Trust"

## Introduction

\*Paul wrote to the Roman church the greatest document on our salvation that there is

\*Chap 1-3 - slavery to sin & need of righteousness

\*Chap 3-4 - how righteousness is given

Are you in right standing with God?

If you died today, would you be allowed into God's presence?

\*People often answer, "I have faith". Faith in what?

What are you trusting in as the means to grant you everlasting life? <u>Today, the trap of misplaced trust</u>

## We'll examine 3 things people place their trust in hoping that it will grant them eternal life

We do this by looking at the example of Abraham

## 1<sup>st</sup> thing some put their faith in is their own good works (Vs 1-8)

Read Vs 1-2

- 1. They considered Abe the father of them all, yet he lived *before* the Law was even given
- 2. If righteousness is earned by things we do, then there is boasting

Read Vs 3-4

- 1. Vs 3 is a quote from Gen 15
- 2. If by works, then righteousness is given b/c it's owed, not b/c of God's gracious gift

Read Vs 5

- 1. We're given righteousness when we believe Jesus wants to grant it while we're yet ungodly
- 2. Doing good is the <u>result</u> of righteousness, not the method of gaining righteousness
- 3. Righteousness can't be of our works, b/c we've already proven ourself to be ungodly
