## Titus 3 – 14 April 2024 "Profiting From A Church Set In Order"

## Introduction

- \*During the writing of this letter, Titus was setting the churches in order on the Island nation of Crete
- \*Tradition says he dies as Bishop of Crete late in life
- \*Chap 1 Paul began w/ instruction on *spiritually* setting things in order on Crete
  - \*Offer hope of the gospel & work w/ godly people
- \*Chap 2 Paul instructed on *practically* setting things in order on Crete
  - \*Living w/ sobriety & godly character
- \*If Chapters 1&2 was how to clean up your life, then Chap 3 is how to profit from a cleaned-up life

# Today, we'll see 4 ways to profit from a Church that is set in order

## #1 – By Meek Citizenry (Vs 1-3)

#### Read Vs 1

- 1. Have a reputation as a good citizen
- 2. Paul told Tim to have the Ephesians pray for rulers, here Titus is given to lead the Cretens in simple obedience they ask, you do
- 3. Turn to Rom 13:1-7
  - a. Certain we don't follow any authority over us in any realm when they direct a sinful action
  - b. Heb 13:17 says they'll give an account of how they did
  - c. But do we have a heart to obey authority seeing how God can use our obedience

#### Read Vs 2

- 1. Don't "speak evil" of anyone, but we certainly need to sometimes speak of someone's evil
  - a. Paul spoke of Alex doing evil (II Tim 4:14) to warn others
  - b. Don't speak dishonestly, yet we may need to speak honestly of one's evil words/deeds

- 2. Simply seek to build bridges, not walls between
- 3. Show 'meekness', restrained power as a horse
- 4. Why should we act such as vs 2? B/c of vs 3

#### Read Vs 3

- 1. Very reason we should show compassion & grace to those sinning, is b/c we've also done it
- 2. Notice they're 'serving' sin by nature (Eph 2:3)
  - a. We were enslaved to sin as they now are
  - b. Shouldn't we have love for the enslaved?

## #2 - By Proper Motivation (Vs 4-7)

#### Read Vs 4-5a

- 1. In our state of enslavement, God reached to us
- a. We didn't reach out to God or fix ourselves
  2. Read Rom 5:6, 8 when we were w/o strength
  - & yet ungodly sinners Christ died for us
    - a. Shall we not do the same?
- 3. Reading your Bible, coming to church & giving money are great works but cannot save you
  - a. It's His mercy to accept us into His family

#### Read Vs 5b-6

- 1. "Washing of regeneration" regeneration is literally 'born again'
  - a. Jesus said unless a person is born again, he can't see the Kingdom of God
- 2. So, is the washing literal washing like baptism?
  - a. Only other time 'washing' is used (Read Eph 5:26), the washing is spiritual
    - i. God cleaning us with His Word
  - b. When Jesus was washing feet, Peter thought he needed a complete washing or bath
    - i. Jesus said once you're washed you only need to wash your feet b/c you're already clean
- 3. "Renewing of the H.S." this is how we're born again, by the life of the Holy Spirit coming in us
- 4. Notice we, right now, have abundant access to Holy Spirit
  - a. Read Luke 11:13 quickly available
  - b. Read John 7:37-39 abundantly available

#### Read Vs 7

- 1. Jesus has given to us the gift of His family money
- 2. How did we become heirs? Ee became His kids
  - a. Paul told Romans (8:17) that we've become children of God & if children then we're heirs
- 3. Well, what do we inherit?
  - a. James says (2:5) we are heirs of the very Kingdom of God

## #3 – By Avoiding Distractions (Vs 8-11)

#### Read Vs 8

- 1. Faith alone saves, but faith that saves is never alone, it's accompanied by a good life
  - a. David Guzik said, "we must never get the cart of good works ahead of the horse of grace"
- 2. Good works should naturally spring up from a life being lived by the H.S. as fruit in a garden
- 3. How can we be "careful"?
  - a. Doesn't take sweat to do great work for God
  - b. It takes a great work of God in us not to sweat it

- c. Don't let our time & energy to be spent on God be choked out by this world's pleasures
- 4. Notice "these things are profitable" Living for Jesus isn't just right, but it's good!

#### Read Vs 9-11

- 1. Attempt to help someone who's tripped up w/ distractions & knit-picking, but don't try endlessly
  - a. There're always endless opinions about how to apply the good principles of God Word
  - b. There're always endless very minor viewpoints on current events questions
- 2. Avoid these situations and continue into the profitable, good Word of God

## #4 – By Doing All Necessary Functions (Vs 12-15)

#### Read Vs 12-13

1. Paul intends to send a close friend from himself unto Crete so Titus can come see Paul

- a. Tychicus specifically is mentioned often as a beloved & faithful servant of the Lord
- 2. In return, Titus would come to Paul at Nicopolis w/ Zenas & Apollos
  - a. Apollos (Acts 18) knew only John's baptism & grew, then he's in I Cor & they're still friends
- 3. The mention of Artemis & Zenas & Nicopolis should remind us, God works even in the places & thru people that <u>very few have even heard of</u>
- a. God has a work in <u>our town</u>, <u>thru us</u> as well Read Vs 14
  - 1. Don't just be a happy paperweight
  - 2. Christians should learn all the basic skills of life & not depend on others for these necessities
    - a. We should be the ones helping the unbelieving world when they have needs

#### Read Vs 15

1. We need God's grace to follow in the footsteps of Jesus Christ

- 1. **Be Meek Citizens**: what's the profit in that?
  - a. <u>Good relationships</u> make it easy to share Christ with the world

  - a. <u>Correct hearts</u> make it easy <u>to want to</u> share Christ
- 3. **Avoid Distractions**: what's the profit in that?

  - a. <u>Job skills</u> give us <u>practical resources</u> to share Christ
