# Ezra 9 – 13 March 2016 – Growing intimacy with God thru water-skiing

## <u>Introduction</u> –

We met Ezra in chapter 7-8. He did great things for the Lord b/c

- 1) Planned his life around pleasing God
- 2) He wanted to spiritually enlighten God's people.
- 3) He talked ANG walked by faith.

Ezra really prospered. How do we use our prosperity?

- 4) Prosperity of money
- 5) Prosperity of time
- 6) Prosperity of relationships

In great wealth, advancement and popularity comes great opportunity to indulge the flesh. (We don't want to do this...we want intimacy with God)

Set up analogy of a stream; don't want to drift downstream with the world, but want to go up-stream to heaven. (Heb 2:1) (Persuade why we should want to go up-stream with Christ) This is akin to our intimacy with our Maker and Redeemer!!

### How to water-ski upstream....with the Lord

Chapter 9:1-7

- 1. 1<sup>st</sup> thing we need to do is: Take the safety rules seriously
  - a. Can't have skis of different length (Don't be unequally yoked)
    - 1. Read II Cor 6:14;18
    - 2. Can you imagine having 2 different types of skis?
  - b. Be w/ people that will help you to ski (Stay in fellowship w/ likeminded Christians)
    - 1. Read Amos 3:1-3
    - 2. In a physical endeavor, need to be on the same page physically. (Building a championship football team) You have to discriminate!

- 3. In a mental endeavor, need to be on the same page mentally. (Building a rocket)
- 4. In a spiritual endeavor, need to be on the same page spiritually. (Building the kingdom of God)
- c. Safety rules are for our protection, not to limit us.
  - i. God's commands to keep your distance from the unbelievers are designed to aid us in raising Godly children and having a Godly legacy to come.

# Chapter 9:8-9

- 2. 2<sup>nd</sup> thing we need to do is: Take our lead from the driver & go w/ the flow.
  - a. Accept this gracious power given to you(We've been bought w/ a price to go His way)
    - 1. Many see our service to Christ to be as limited slaves. Yet in reality we've been given power beyond our ability.

- 2. "Silver and gold have I none, but what I do have..."
- 3. We been given the power to forgive and love...we didn't have this before.
- b. Go where He leads (Work on spiritual tasks, not fleshly)
  - 1. If you try to turn to left or right, will fail.
  - 2. We need to follow after holiness not happiness, after character not comfort.

## Chapter 9:10-15

- 3. 3<sup>rd</sup> thing we need to do is: Accept our helplessness & the driver's ability.
  - a. Accept that you can do nothing, if you don't hold on.
    - 1. In the spirit we can accomplish great things. But if we let go of the rope, even or best efforts will still see us get swept down-stream.

- 2. Ask the Lord if He's leading every effort of our lives. If no, then it's a totally worthless endeavor.
- b. Accept that the driver is perfect.
  - 1. Jesus will never lead us into something without cause.

### <u>Conclusion</u> –
