# Introduction to Israelology -

Chapter 12 is foundational -unless you understand God's purpose for Israel, you'll have a confused view of what the Bible is all about.

- . <u>Christology</u> The study of Christ
- <u>Ecclesiology</u> The study of the church
- <u>Eschatology</u> The study of the end times
- . <u>Hamartiology</u> The study of sin
- . <u>Pneumatology</u> The study of the Holy Spirit
- <u>Soteriology</u> The study of salvation
- <u>Theological anthropology</u> The study of humanity.
  Systematic Theology misses Israel!!!

## How is your Israelology? And why does it matter?

Read Chapter 12 Vs 1-2

1. If pregnant one=church, then we're in trouble!

- a. Church–Virgin Bride of Christ (II Cor 11:2, Rev 19:7)
- b. Israel wife of God (Eze 16:8, Jer 31:32)
- c. Most commentators get this wrong
- d. God is pleased when we piece things together and obey, just like parents.
- 2. The law of first mention (Gen 37:5-10)
  - a. Israel often described as a woman is travail.
    - i. Isa 54:5, 66:7, Jer 3:6, Mic 4:10, 5:2-3
  - b. Israel was anticipated to be mother of Messiah
    - i. Isa 6:9 unto us child is born, son is given
    - ii. Gen 3:15, Gal 3:16, 19
  - c. From the very beginning (Jacob) to the end.
  - d. The Zodiac (or Hb Mazzeroth)=12 stars
- 3. Replacement Theology (R. T.)
  - a. Def Since Israel rejected God, Church has become spiritual Israel getting their promises.
  - b. It's dangerous b/c it makes God a liar.
    - i. Israelology matter b/c it shows us that God will fulfill <u>all</u> that He says.

- c. Major Problems
  - i. Promises to Israel were unconditional
    - 1. Abraham had nothing to add to the covenant that God made (Gen 15)
  - ii. Romans stresses God's not done w/ Israel
    - 1. Paul in Rom 9-11
  - iii. Ignores Daniel's 70 Weeks prophecy
  - iv. Jesus needs to yet reign on the Throne of David. (Luke 1:21)
- d. Israelology matter b/c it shows us that there's no reason to take God's promises as anything but <u>literal</u> and <u>true</u>.
  - i. Then were did R. T. come from?
    - 1. Origen's allegorical interpretations.
    - 2. Augustine used Origen to develop Amillennial Eschatology.
      - a. Hard to be literal (re: Christ overthrowing the govt) when you're a state paid pastor

ii. Led to Medieval church's quest for power

### iii. Reformation

- 1. Wonderful job fixing soteriology
- 2. Ignored Augustine bad Eschatology
- iv. This led to holocaust
  - 1. R.T. drove people to advance their own kingdom
  - 2. R.T. drove people to anti-Semitism
  - 3. Blame? Start by blaming the silent pulpits!
  - v. R.T. and anti-Semitism will lead to Armageddon
- 4. They're His chosen people, chosen for what?
  - a. Chosen to be an example to the church (I Cor 10:6-11)
  - b. Chosen to bring forth His eternal Word (John 17:20)
  - c. Chosen to bring forth the Messiah to sit on David's throne (Isa 61:1)
    - i. Israelology matter b/c it shows us the depth of meaning and purpose God has

# for each, can't just replace Israel's purposes.

#### Conclusion to part 1 -

Israelology matter for these reasons:

1) Shows that God will fulfill <u>all</u> that He says.

2) Shows that there's no reason to take God's promises as anything but <u>literal</u> and <u>true</u>.

3) Shows the depth of meaning/purpose God has for each, can't just be replaced.
