Jude 1-11 – 12 October 2025 "Earnestly Contend For The Faith: Pt 1 of 2"

Introduction

- *Short letters aren't throwaways, but packed w/ power
- *We are the representations of God on earth; we are to set a difference between our lifestyle & that of the unbelievers
 - *Turn to Eph 5:8-16 & Turn to I Thes 5:2-8
- *Let's jump into vss 1-3 to let Jude give us his intro

Read Vs 1

- 1. This Jude (Judas) is the brother of James the leader of the early Jerusalem Church (Acts 15)
 - a. They're half-brothers of Jesus (Matt 13:55)
- 2. Judas takes the title doulos of Jesus his brother
 - a. This is powerful b/c it's what he chose; not what nature forced on him
- 3. He writes describing all believers accurately
 - a. Called God initiated this work in us
 - b. <u>Beloved</u> Brought into what is good

- i. Some translations say 'sanctified' (or being crafted into what is good)
- c. <u>Kept</u> Preserved in an unbreakable bond
- 4. These 3 verbs make a beautiful picture
 - a. God opens His arms to us calling us in, embraces us in His arms and never lets go

Read Vs 2

1. Jude isn't content to just wish these virtues were <u>added</u> to us, but that they would be <u>multiplied</u> to us

Read Vs 3

- 1. H.S. superseded what Jude intended to write
 - a. Always be flexible to change our words or actions when the Lord speaks to us afresh
- 2. H.S. adjusted Jude to say 'earnestly contend for the faith' or fight to hold their belief in truth
 - a. Read I Tim 6:12 When we were born, we entered the boxing ring
 - b. Do we want to be on the offense or just get smacked around by the blows of this world?

- c. We're told 'weapons of our warfare aren't earthly but they're spiritual able to pull down mental & spiritual strongholds' (II Cor 10:3-5)
- d. We put on these weapons like armor (Eph 6)
- 3. Now what we're to contend for is this <u>belief</u> system that was given once and never needs fixed or added to
 - a. We don't need another Testament, another Gospel, or another Savior
 - b. We're speaking of Mormons & every other group that changes the truth of this book (Read Gal 1:8)
- 4. If you've changed to something other than this Bible, you've been given a lie
 - a. Satan loves to come in looking shiny & good and then sells you a pallet of lies

In these two sessions, we'll see 6 ways that we should be earnestly contending for the true faith

We'll look at 2 of these 6 ways today

#1 – We don't waste our resources on ourselves as the false converts do (Vs 4-7)

Read Vs 4

- 1. Salvation by God's grace is to be honored
 - a. Read Gal 5:13-14 Our freedom in Christ isn't to be used for selfishness but for godliness
 - b. Paul said, 'though I'm free from all men, yet I have made myself servant to all, that I might gain the more' (I Cor 9:19)
- 2. We need do nothing but believe in God's grace at the cross for salvation
 - a. Now will we use this experience to self or the advancement of making Jesus known?
 - b. Beware of those that creep in consuming upon self

Read Vs 5-7

1. These are all 3 examples of those that had a position of good or salvation & choose to leave it

- a. Vs 5, Moses' Israel left off believing God& were destroyed in the wilderness
- b. Vs 6, Some angels left off believing God (became demons) & are held for destruction in tarturos (II Pet 2)
- c. Vs 7, People of Sodom left off believing God's method of human sexuality & became an earthly picture of receiving destruction in hell fire
- 2. God knows how to mark the unbelievers for destruction w/o missing a one (Read II Pet 2:9)
- 3. In all these examples there is a pride of not being content with what God has provided
 - a. It's the same for these men; they're taking their salvation freedom & gifts & using them for self

#2 – We don't war against authorities & powers (Vs 8-11)

Read Vs 8-9

- 1. These men live in lies of illusions, like dreams
- 2. They misunderstand authority in all realms
 - a. They misuse the <u>flesh</u> trying to use it instead of killing it
 - b. They misuse authority or dominions of this world
 - c. They rail against or try taking authority over glorious ones or dignities which are demonic forces
 - i. Even Michael can't take authority over Satan; they're equals, only God can
 - d. What is our position toward demonic forces?
 - i. It's not to condemn or bind them, that's God's job
 - ii. It's to withstand their lies by God's Word
 - 1. Jesus at His temptation in Luke 4
 - 2. Read Eph 6:12-13

3. Don't take this false position of power that these ungodly people take – but take the image of Christ and that of humility (see Phil 2)

Read Vs 10

- 1. How can we know anything of the eternal realm whether in heaven or hell unless the Lord reveals it
 - a. We too often speak proudly of matters we don't know of (Read Job 38:2 darks counsel by words without knowledge)
 - b. When the Bible is silent, be silent; but when the Bible speaks give it boldly

Read Vs 11a

- 1. Cain couldn't live under the authority of what God wanted of him spiritually (anger)
- 2. Read Heb 11:4 Abel acted by faith, Cain couldn't
- 3. Thought to gain independence, but gained bondage

Read Vs 11b

- 1. Balaam couldn't live w/ prosperity only by godly means but wanted it at any cost (greed)
- 2. Thought to give cursing, but gave blessing

Read Vs 11c

- 1. Korah couldn't live under God's appointed authority (Moses) in his own good position (pride)
- 2. They thought to gain more power & position, but gained death

Conclusion

Are you in the fight? We're to fight the good fight of faith as a good soldier of Christ

- 1. Let's use our resources on glorifying God and advancing the purposes of God
- 2. Let's be humble and content with our station in life w/o bucking against authorities
 - a. Jesus humbled Himself to a low station and yet accomplished Great things!
