Luke 5:17-39 – 26 February 2023 "The Worst Made Wealthy"

Introduction

*Chap 4 we began to see *operation* of Jesus ministry *Jesus has begun teaching people of His identity *He's begun to call people to follow Him as Lord *The call of Jesus...

*Isn't just to bring our earthly life blessings
*But it's to bring our dead spirit into eternal life!
*In Galilee, Jesus has already called some fishermen
to be His disciples or students, today he'll call another
*The Bible speaks a lot of receiving Jesus & receiving
His Word

*Let's look at what it is that we receive anyway Today, we'll see 3 gifts to be opened at the receiving of Jesus into our lives and continually

1st Gift: Forgiveness – Jesus has the power to forgive the most sinful (Vs 17-26)

Read Vs 17 – Palsied man healed thru the roof

1. Not wrong that they came to investigate Jesus but they need to be open to reality of what they see

Read Vs 18-19

1. Faith will push thru adversities and not stop

Read Vs 20

- 1. 'Saw their faith': real faith is evidenced by actions
- 2. Faith makes us eligible to receive of God
 - a. And on this day, the power of God was present to heal him
- 3. Notice Jesus always addresses the most important subject first, his sins, not his body
 - a. Exp: Read John 3:2-3 Nicodemus: miracles; Jesus "you must be born again"
 - b. Exp: Read Mark 12:18 'whose wife is she'; Jesus you err b/c you don't know Bible
 - c. We often pray for a thing & God is wanting to address the more important situation first

Read Vs 21

- 1. It's right that only God can forgive sins; it's wrong that this is blasphemy
 - a. Read Gen 39:9 Joseph's potential adultery would have been against God
 - b. Read Psm 51:4 David, 'against Thee only'
- 2. Would be blasphemy if Jesus wasn't God

Read Vs 22

1. Why the reaction that Jesus is doing wrong?

Read Vs 23-24

- 1. It's easy to say it, but He now gives them direct evidence to believe it by healing
- 2. Jesus is trying to give them every reason to believe that He truly is God
 - a. Power is *exousia* for authority or jurisdiction, not *dunamis* which is power

Read Vs 25-26

- 1. What is the result? Glory to God
- 2. Matt 9:8 says they gloried that God had "given such power unto men"

2nd Gift: Peace – Jesus has love for the most scornful (Vs 27-32)

Read Vs 27-28 – The call of Matthew to follow

- 1. This is Matthew called Levi
 - a. Matthew (Mark 2:14) & James the Less (Matt 10:3) are both called the son of Alphaeus i. Maybe they're brothers
 - b. How much did Matthew already know and hear about Jesus before this encounter?
- 2. Matthew left ALL and followed Jesus
 - a. Read Luke 9:23 deny self, take cross, follow Jesus
 - b. Easier to go back to fishing for Peter than going back to tax collecting for Matthew
 - c. Matthew value system radically changedi. His value in taxes AND in Jesus both
- 3. Jesus loved this hated tax-collector
 - a. Read Luke 7:47: forgiven much, love much

Read Vs 29

1. Telling friends is evidence of a changed life

Read Vs 30-32

- 1. Sinners are those whose occupation made them ceremonially unclean
- 2. They're not having a meal for fellowship, but for evangelism; He's there to be a doctor to them
- 3. There're none that are whole or righteous, but there are those that are righteous in their own eyes
- 4. Matt 9:13 says Jesus added a quote from (Read) Hos 6:6a mercy not sacrifice
 - a. <u>Mercy</u> for those that can't help themselves
 - b. <u>Sacrifice</u> is from those that have something to offer
 - c. Same thought is in (Read) I Sam 15:22
 - d. Also Read Hos 6:6b Fear of God is the beginning of knowledge (from Prov 1:7)
- 5. We too need to reach out to those that KNOW they have problems & sins
 - a. Tom P. testimony: "You are so angry, but all I can see is a crying little boy that just wants to be loved. God loves you!"

3rd Gift: Joy – Jesus has grace for the most sorrowful (Vs 33-39)

Read Vs 33-35

- 1. The complaint was, "aren't you acting too happy or irreverently?"
 - a. Pharisees mourned longing for Messiah to deliver them from Roman
 - b. John Baptist's disciples mourned longing for Messiah to come
 - c. Physical act of mourning/fasting (or not) has to correctly represent the spiritual reality
 - d. Jesus' disciples rejoiced in the presence of Messiah
- 2. Theses Pharisees would reject any approach b/c it wasn't their approach (Read Matt 11:16-19)
 - it wasn't their approach (Read Matt 11:16-19)
- 3. This is 1st reference to the heavenly wedding
 - a. Children of the bridegroom is Israel
 - b. Bride is the church (Read Rom 7:4)
 - c. John Baptist is best man (Read Jhn 3:29)
 - d. Jesus is here on earth to take a bride!
- 4. There's a time to fast/mourn, this ain't it!!

Read Vs 36-39

- 1. (Explain the 2 analogies) You can't add the new to the old b/c the old is already stretched
- 2. Jesus is here to complete the Law, but He's here to do something new also!
 - Remember Rom 7:4 completion of the Law means dead to the 1st & freedom to live for another
 - b. We live by a new standard...that of grace
 - c. Read John 1:17 "grace and truth"
- 3. The teachings of grace cannot fit within the old system of the Law

Conclusion

So you say you've received Jesus into your life?

1. Are you experiencing His forgiveness?

- a. Jesus has the power to forgive even the most sinful of people
- b. Even if we're never healed of any earthly ailment, Jesus has already healed our greatest problem....that of a blacked soul

2. Are you experiencing His peace?

- a. Jesus has the love for even the most scornful of people
- b. Even if no one else ever shows us affection, Jesus will never stop loving us

3. Are you experiencing His Joy?

- a. Jesus has the grace for even the most sorrowful of people
- Even if this life is only hard continually,
 Jesus has set aside eternity for us to continually
 experience His everlasting joy!
