I Thessalonians 2 – 12 November 2023 "Effecting Our Friends With Jesus"

Introduction

*Paul went to Thessalonica on 2nd Missionary Trip w/ Silas & Timothy

*Just after Philippi (jailor) & before Berea (noble) *Only there for 3 weeks & 3 months at most

*Then they went on the Athens (Unknown God)

*It's amazing what the Lord can do in a life in a very short period of time!

*In Chap 1: Paul commended them for their immediate, giant expressions of faith, love & hope in their new life

*Now in Chap 2: Paul more focuses on the <u>sincerity</u> of the interactions between him & the Thessalonians

*Let us learn to imitate the example Paul gives us *Just as Paul said in (Read) I Thes 1:6

*Let us be so ready to love our friends w/ Jesus that we soak in this example from the Word of God **Today, let's see 4 parts to this idea of effecting our friends with Jesus**

1st part is the Method: Have sincere intention thru bold contention (Vs 1-4)

Read Vs 1-2

- Paul & team didn't hold back or get shy b/c of their abuse at Philippi
- 2. Even at Thessalonica there was much dust being stirred up & yet they were boldly preaching
- 3. "With much contention" the idea is stiving or fighting thru the hindrances to give the Gospel
 - a. Same word as "fight" (the good fight of faith) from I Tim 6:12

Read Vs 3-4

- 1. We're just to give what God gave us
 - a. We don't trick people or lie to them
 - b. We don't offer the Gospel w/ a side of worldly allure (uncleanness)
- 2. We've been entrusted with something that's already complete & we don't have the option to change it to make it more palatable to people

Conclusion to Point #1

- 1. So what method are you using to reach friends?
- 2. Read II Cor 2:15-17
- 3. Let's be sure to deliver the simple truth
- 4. When we put out the sincere yet amazing message of Jesus it'll stir up contention to some
- 5. Let it do it's work thru the power of the H.S.

2nd part is the Motive: Not for greedy gain, but for generous giving (Vs 5-9)

Read Vs 5

1. They didn't come appearing to want to help but really only wanting to <u>take riches</u>

Read Vs 6

1. They didn't come <u>seeking respect & applause</u> even though they deserved honor as Apostles

Read Vs 7

1. They didn't just come with a <u>sterile message</u> but to carefully give it to them

Read Vs 8-9

- 1. Witnessing should be an <u>offering of your</u> <u>whole being</u> to the person
 - a. We give spiritually the Gospel of life
 - b. We give mentally <u>our attention</u> to them as an individual
 - c. We give physically our tangible love
- "Not be chargeable" Do everything we can to be seen as givers and not takers

Conclusion to Point #2

- 1. What motivates you to share Jesus?
- 2. Read Tit 1:10-11
- 3. The <u>selfish should be silenced</u> & the <u>lovers</u> <u>should get loud</u>

3rd part is the Minister: Personal purity & passion for people (Vs 10-13)

Read Vs 10-11

1. What hinders us from encouraging others to walk worthy (appropriately) of our new life?

- a. Habitual sin? <u>Choose to change</u> & get in a position to encourage others into godliness as a good father would his children
- b. Feeling imperfect? You'll never be good enough or clean enough to start being a leader
 - i. But God has cleansed us making us good enough – go do it

Read Vs 12

- Realize what goodness we've been brought into at conversion – it's glorious
- 2. When we realize it, we'll labor to bring Him honor for we see Him as worthy of it

Read Vs 13

- 1. What a time to rejoice when people accept that we're not trying to promote our church, or "our truth"
 - a. But they see that we're just a conduit for the flow of God's eternal love thru His Word

4th part is the Members: Our goal is their glorification (Vs 14-20)

Read Vs 14

- 1. So they received the Gospel regardless of whether their friends liked it or not
- 2. It's like trying to be a NY Giants fan in Eagles country you know what you're getting into
- 3. We've embraced a new identity as citizens of a new country

Read Vs 15

 He's comforting the Thessalonians w/ the idea <u>they're on the right track</u>, the <u>same track</u> as all the Christians before them & the Lord Jesus Himself

Read Vs 16

 Interesting when someone goes farther than just not wanting the Gospel to even not wanting others to hear it either – This is evil Read Vs 17-18

- 1. He wants them to know the reason he hasn't come back isn't for lack of desire
 - a. He hasn't lost his <u>connection of affection</u>
- 2. There is spiritual warfare that has hindered him
 - a. The Lord gave Paul insight into this spiritual reality (Read Act 16:8-10)
 - b. Daniel was shown the "behind the scenes"
- 3. Notice 3 things about this spiritual warfare
 - a. Paul acknowledged <u>it's real & can hinder</u> even an apostle
 - b. Paul knew Satan <u>couldn't last forever</u> (Only for a short time)
 - c. <u>Paul never stopped</u> going even while hindered

Read Vs 19-20

- 1. So the redirect from Paul <u>to</u> the Lord
 - a. What's more important than being w/ Paul?i. Being with Jesus!
- 2. Paul shows his connection of affection for them by the expression that he needs no other reward than to know that they'll be w/ Jesus forever

Conclusion

So how are we doing with giving our friends Jesus?

- 1. What method are we using?
 - a. Don't overcomplicate it, give them the simple truth
 - b. There will be contention w/ some, but others, it's be like gaining a new best friend!

2. What motivates us to give them Jesus?

- a. It's possible to share Jesus in a haughty, prideful way that doesn't care for them
- b. See them as a soul headed for hell & then we'll reach out in compassion

3. What kind of minister are you?

- a. Don't stop just b/c we're not perfect!
- b. We're not offering them our perfect life, but the perfect life of Jesus

4. Who are the members?

- a. We're trying to aid people from conversion, thru discipleship, right to glorification!
- b. Are we offering our whole life to bring them the salvation that we so richly cherish?
