# Luke 4:15-44 – 5 February 2023 "Who Do You Think Jesus Is?"

## **Introduction**

- \*Luke began w/ the *preparation* of the ministry of Jesus Christ showing His baptism and temptation
- \*Chap 4 we begin to see the *operation* of His ministry
- \*John 1-4 has already happened w/ Jesus going about Judea, Samaria and Galilee
- \*Now Jesus goes home to Nazareth where He grew up
- \*Today we focus on the identity of Jesus
  - \*Was He just a good man or prophet?
  - \*Was He a liar or in it for Himself?
- \*We have already seen both God the Father & Satan declare Jesus as the Son of God

Today, we'll see 3 attributes we need to possess to benefit from the identity of Jesus

# 1<sup>st</sup> attribute needed to benefit from the identity of Jesus is faith (Vs 15-30)

## Read Vs 15-16 – Nazareth Synagogue

- 1. His teaching is already being well-received all over Israel as He travels
- 2. Notice Jesus never forsook assembling together
- 3. Travelling or visiting Rabbis were often asked to do the reading & the sermon (as Paul often was)

#### Read Vs 17-20

- 1. This would have seemed unusually short to them not the whole section of Isa 61
- 2. What does this message say?
  - a. God is leading Me in all I do for I'm the Anointed One which is to say the Christ
  - b. 5-fold effects of sin & Jesus the cure
    - i. <u>Poor</u> Sin impoverishes but Christ will teach you the way to satisfaction
    - ii. <u>Brokenhearted</u> Sin breaks relationships but Christ will bring people back together
    - iii. <u>Captives</u> Sin enslaves but Christ will deliver us out of being forced into sin

- iv. <u>Blind</u> Sin blind our direction & wisdom but Christ will give us direction & wisdom
  - 1. Interesting: Jesus pulled this from Isa 42:7, not from passage He was reading
- v. <u>Bruised</u> Sin wounds its victims but Christ provides freedom away from wounds
- 3. They stood to read Bible, then sat to teach
- 4. What does this message NOT say?
  - a. Jesus cut this short to express a divide in the purposes of the Messiah
  - b. He didn't read "The day of vengeance..."
  - c. He'll perform some parts now & some later

#### Read Vs 21-22a

- 1. That very day Jesus was already anointed, sent, preaching, healing & setting free (all the verbs)
- 2. Everyone's first response is 'this is wonderful'

## Read Vs 22b-24

1. They begin to doubt that a man (& one they know well) could possibly be Messiah

- 2. This Hometown Crowd is epitomized by the expression "We know who You are not"
- 3. Jesus knows they're gonna ask for Him to heal all bodily needs, like He's already been doing, but He's there for so much more than that
  - a. Jesus emphasizes His *prophetic* mission more than His *healing* mission
  - b. He wants them to focus more on believing than on receiving

### Read Vs 25-28

- 1. These examples illustrate two principles
  - a. God isn't bias, but looks for faith
  - b. Don't look at messenger but the message to come to God by faith
- 2. They're angry b/c He's making case, 'you're not special b/c you're in Israel or of my family

### Read Vs 29-30

- 1. Seems to be a miracle that He walked thru
- 2. The fickleness of man One minute they love you & the next they want you dead

# $2^{nd}$ attribute needed to benefit from the identity of Jesus is submission (Vs 31-37)

Read Vs 31-32 – Capernaum Synagogue Demon

- 1. Jesus taught as one having authority (within Himself) and not as the scribes
- 2. Scribes just quoted another teacher's interpretation; Jesus' interpretation resonated as true

### Read Vs 33-34

- 1. This guy with an evil spirit 'came to church every Sunday' (Crow & Dove Story)
  - a. Same as the damsel in Act 16:16
  - b. What did he do every week? Hinder people from receiving the truth
- 2. Demons are smart
  - a. They know they're appointed to destruction
  - b. They know who Jesus is in power & purity
  - c. They know they failed to corrupt Him at His temptation by Satan
- 3. These demons are epitomized by the expression "We know who You are"

#### Read Vs 35

- 1. Jesus wants to <u>heal</u> but not <u>reveal</u> at this time
- 2. There's never much attention given to demonic

### Read Vs 36-37

- 1. They were astonished at His teaching & now at his power over the spiritual realm of devils
- 2. His words and actions aligned

# 3<sup>rd</sup> attribute needed to benefit from the identity of Jesus is priority (Vs 38-44)

# Read Vs 38-39 – *Many healings*

- 1. The only proper response to receiving grace is to serve
- 2. Notice Jesus does private miracles as well as public ones
  - a. He's not doing it for the publicity and fame
  - b. He's doing it for His great love & compassion

- 3. So Simon Peter was married
  - a. Catholics claim Peter as the 1<sup>st</sup> Pope (he wasn't), then why do they disallow marriage?
  - b. Read I Tim 4:1-3 forbidding to marry

### Read Vs 40-41

- 1. Many healings but not time to gain attention
- 2. Now we have the Father (3:22), the devil (4:3) & demons declaring Jesus as the Son of God
- a. In mouth of 2-3 witnesses a thing is established Read Vs 42-44
  - 1. Jesus cared for people constantly, but the focus was the teaching
  - 2. There was enough need & desire that He could have spent 100% of His time healing
    - a. That's only of temporary benefit
    - b. That ultimately still sends them to hell
  - 3. The multitudes are epitomized by the expression "We know who we want You to be"

### Conclusion

We need to see Jesus for who He really is to benefit from His life in us

- 1. We need faith to rid ourselves of this curse of familiarity
  - a. Have we stopped asking God to do great things in our lives b/c we have become so accustom to our religious routines?
- 2. We need submission to rid ourselves of serving our own will
  - a. Have we set up our will and desire as more important that His plans and His glory?
- 3. We need priority to rid ourselves of looking only on the temporary & earthly
  - a. Have we lost focus on living for eternal things like people's salvation & Christian growth b/c we think only of comfort in the here & now?

Read Matt 16:13-17 — We need to ask the Father to renew us spiritually to see Jesus for who He really is!!
