Psalms 106 – 10 August 2025 "Utterly Helpless, But God"

Introduction

- *This is 6th of 6 messages in the 4th Book of Psalms
- *Psalms the Israeli Hymnbook or Book of Praises
- *The human condition is such that at our very best, we still find we're unable to succeed in serving God faithfully
- *We find that apart from God's enablement, we slide farther & farther into the consequences of our nature
- *Read Rom 7:22-8:1 We can only find good and be satisfied when we're empowered by God to serve God
- *So today we'll realize 3 things that will enable us to victoriously enjoy serving God

#1 – We See Our Desired Direction – The Wise Want To Do Well (Vs 1-5)

Read Vs 1

- 1. God is always the initiator, we're the responder
- 2. It's imperative that we respond w/ praise & thanks to God's lovingkindness

Read Vs 2-3

- 1. For those that love God, there is a spiritual energy for the doing of what's pleasing to the Lord a. "Thanksdoing" is the result of a heart of thanksgiving
- 2. It's impossible to do righteousness at all times
 - a. But we are ones that are constantly desiring& heading in that direction
 - b. Vs 2 says we can't even <u>speak</u> all of God's praise let alone <u>act</u> perfectly to show praise

Read Vs 4-5

1. We picture the prodigal son coming home (coming toward righteousness) & then His father coming running to meet him (to bring gifts)

- 2. If it's not for our God giving us entrance & salvation, we could never get into the destination
- 3. What God built them was a nation w/ inheritance
 - a. What He's built for us is the Church, the one that confess...
 - i. Our desire to live for him\
 - ii. Our need for Jesus Christ

#2 – We See Our Deep Delinquency – We Witness Our Worthlessness (Vs 6-43)

Read Psm 106:6-7

- 1. Psalmist confesses that as a nation they still find themselves in the condition of rebellion
 - a. As their ancestors complained as the plagues were falling, *they still rebel in heart*
- 2. Why? B/c they didn't trust that if God delivered before, He could do it again

Read Vs 8-12

1. God saves His people at the Red Sea & then they believed that He's a saving God

2. Do you see their problem here? No faith

- a. Read John 20:27-29 Saving faith is based on the unseen & surrounding evidence, not direct evidence
- b. Read Rom 10:17 Biblical, saving faith comes from hearing not seeing

Read Vs 13-15

- 1. Do you see their problem here? Lust for comfort & ease
- 2. God tends to afflict the comfortable and comfort the afflicted
- 3. We will either seek our own counsel or God's
 - a. Seeking our way, we'll never be satisfied
 - b. When we receive what our amazing counsel asks for, we often find it empty and harmful

Read Vs 16-18

- 1. Do you see their problem here? Lust for power
- 2. In all these sins there's a discontentment with the great things that God has already provided

a. These men were already priests being used of God, but they wanted MORE

Read Vs 19-23

- 1. Now what's their problem here? Lust for a God made to their own liking
- 2. Remember where the gold for molten image (Golden Calf) came from Egyptian jewelry
 - a. What should be a blessing becomes a curse
 - b. The possession became a perversion, then became a poison b/c God had them drink it
- 3. Lusts always cost more than we wanted to pay

Read Vs 24-27

- 1. This refers to sending the 12 spies in the land
 - a. Israel saw the adversities in Canaan & didn't trust God could deliver them
- 2. They left the good path not just by committing sins, but also by omitting good actions
 - a. Good actions take faith that God can do it
- 3. So here we have the sin of omission

Read Vs 28-31

- 1. In Num 25 Israel was coaxed into sexual activity with neighboring Moab & were plagued
- 2. Now things are so bad that they're being led into sin so passively
- 3. But a bit of the solution is listed right here
 - a. Phinehas sprung into proactive motion & turned the tide and God stayed His judgement

Read Vs 32-33

- 1. Twice Israel was at Meribah
 - a. Exo 17 They begged for water, then God had Moses strike the Rock
 - b. Num 20 They begged for water, God told Moses to speak to the Rock but Moses struck it
- 2. Now their nature even provokes others to sin
 - a. Moses is guilty of his own sin but are we pushing people toward God or toward sin?

Read Vs 34-39

1. Judges 1 details they failure to remove the sinful environment around them in their new land

- 2. Now they've gone so far as to dedicate themselves to studying & serving false gods
- 3. Is there an earthly hobby or pastime that more dedicated to than our dedication to knowing Jesus?

Read Vs 40-43

- 1. Book of Judges shows this cycle of God's deliverance, yet they sink back into rebellion
- 2. Humanity, on our own, has no capacity to stay out of trouble, sin & harmful habits
- 3. This is the depths of our sin that Jesus offers to deliver us from

#3 – We See Our Devoted Deliverer – Our Worthy God Welcomes Us (Vs 44-48)

Read Psm 106:44-46

1. "Nevertheless" – It's not a "less important point to make" to say that....

- a. Although this is Israel's condition & ours, God is faithful & full of lovingkindness for us
- b. Despite our natural condition, God loves us
- 2. He knows all the vices that have & could yet trouble us, and He yet remains committed to us
- 3. Now, what is our part in this deliverance?
 - a. Simply from vs 44, to cry out to Him
 - b. If we confess our sins, He is faithful & just to forgive us and cleanse us for all of it

Read Vs 47-48

- 1. We've been saved & gathered together for the major purpose of thanking God for it
 - a. Thank Him with your renewed mindset
 - b. Thank Him with your words
 - c. Thank Him with your actions & lifestyle
- 2. Jesus lived perfectly & then <u>He</u> offered this perfect righteousness to us (Read II Cor 5:21)
- 3. Let the Lord Jesus Christ be magnified from today and forever!

Conclusion

Have you found this to be reality in your own heart?

- Our Desired Direction Is That We Want To Do Well
- 2. Yet We Have A Deep Delinquency In That We Witness That We're Worthless
- 3. But Praise God, We Have A Devoted Deliverer, Our Worthy God Is Always Ready To Welcome Us Home
