Galatians 3:1-20 – 17 July 2022 "Consistency Of Justification By Faith"

Introduction

*Theme of Book: Self-merit can never justify man, who is sinful by nature, in the presence of God, who is holy by nature

*Galatians Outlined

- *Chap 1-2 Jockeying for justification by faith
- *Chap 3-4 **B**asis of justification by faith
- *Chap 5-6 Fallout from justification by faith
- *Chap 1-2 we saw that in every epoch of time (Creation, Law, Christ), God initiates & completes the work, we just need to contend for and preach it
- *Now in chap 3, Paul shows the consistency of God's plan for all people to live in justification by faith in God's work *He's consistent throughout our life & history
- *So today, here's 3 examples of the consistency of God's plan of justification & salvation

1st example of this consistency is: the way we began in salvation is the way we're to continue (Vs 1-7)

Read Vs 1

- 1. It's either Christ's work, that is complete or we're still in a system of work...it can't be both
- 2. Did His death put to death works or not? Yes! Read Vs 2-3
 - 1. If you've accepted Jesus as the Savior, you've received the Spirit (Read I Cor 12:2-3)
 - a. It's the Spirit that stirs our hearts to accept & believe Gospel (Read I Cor 2:14 & John 16:13)
 - b. The Spirit's ministry in our life is to speak of & exalt Jesus (Read John 15:26)
 - c. It's the Spirit that gifts & empowers us to speak & act for Jesus (Read Act 1:8)
 - 2. What are you led by?
 - a. You're either led of the Spirit that centers you on Jesus' completed work
 - b. Or you're centered on your own futile continuing effort to be complete yourself

- 3. Made perfect in the flesh? We've already been made complete in Christ, no work of our flesh can change or add to perfection
 - a. Read Eph 2:8 & Col 2:9-10

Read Vs 4

1. You begin to read in Act 13 of the strife given to the believers in Galatia; was it all for nothing?

Read Vs 5

- 1. The God that began doing great things in your life, did it b/c of Jesus' life in us, not b/c of us
- 2. Read Phil 1:6 If the Spirit ever leaves us, it's not b/c Jesus abandoned us, but b/c we've returned to works

Read Vs 6-7

- 1. Story of Abe is in Gen 12-23 but it's way back in Gen 15:6 that Abe is declared right w/ God
 - a. This is long before his works of offering of Isaac in Gen 22

- b. The works of Abe are simply proof of his authentic saving faith (see John 8, Jam 2)
- 2. Trusting in God's work has *always been* the plan of God as Abe demonstrated
 - a. Abe isn't the father of Jews, he's the father of believers (Read Rom 4:16)
 - b. This is how Abe is known as the father of many nations in Gen 17:5
- 3. From start to end of Abe's life; he had relationship w/ God by faith in what God was doing

2nd example of this consistency is: Abraham's faith in God is the example for all people & time (Vs 8-14)
Read Vs 8-9

1. In the 1st verses of Abe's story (Gen 12:3) God prophecies that it's having the faith of Abe that will bless or make all the difference for many people in many lands (Read Rom 4:12-13)

Read Vs 10-11

- 1. Bible has always declared that the Law leads to cursing and also that faith leads to righteousness
 - a. Read Deut 27:26 whole Law or nothing
 - b. Read Hab 2:4 Always looking to another

Read Vs 12

- Law & Faith are different; Law depends on us
 & faith depends on Jesus
- 2. Law is good (Psm 19:7) & it's capable, but we're not

Read Vs 13-14

- 1. Everything is put together in these verses
- 2. Jesus took on the Law & won on the cross so the fulfillment of Abe's faith could be realized
- 3. Now the long-promised Spirit of God can be poured into us as new wineskins
 - a. See Isa 32:15, Eze 11:19 & Joel 2:28

3rd example of this consistency is: the Person & method of its fulfillment has never changed (Vs 15-20) Read Vs 15

- 1. "Even in everyday life once someone agrees to a thing, no one else can change or cancel it"
- 2. Insinuation is: How much stronger & better is the promise of God to save us by our faith in Him?
- 3. Jesus has always been the plan

Read Vs 16

- 1. This is Gen 22:18 promising the in the Seed (or descendant) Jesus all the nations shall be blessed
- 2. The work of the Seed Jesus has always been the plan (see Gen 3:15)

Read Vs 17-18

1. Law had to come for a *different reason* rather than bringing justification b/c God's promises of the Seed to come were already made to Abe

- 2. The Law can't change the promise of believing in God's Seed for righteousness
- 3. A promise that God makes can't be changed Read Vs 19-20
 - 1. So the Law wasn't brought for justification but to show what transgression is & only til Jesus
 - 2. Read John 1:17 Law given to Moses by angel mediators; the cross was given by the Son Jesus the Mediator
 - a. B/c of our sin, we can't approach God
 - 3. Vs 20 The Mediator
 - a. Angels mediated God & us in giving Law
 - b. Jesus mediated God & us
 - c. This explains God is one (I Tim 2:5)
 - d. Now we can come boldly to throne of grace as we're told in Heb 4:16

Conclusion

So there's a consistency to God's plan of redemption

- 1. The way we begin our new life in Christ is the way we continue and enter eternity
- 2. Abraham's faith in God is the example for all people of all time
- 3. The Person & method of its fulfillment has never changed

Sending Jesus wasn't some "Plan B". He's prepared this salvation for us since the foundation of the world

- 1. He loved Jesus since foundation (Joh 17:24)
- 2. He chose us since foundation (Eph 1:4)
- 3. We were redeemed w/ precious blood of Christ that was foreordained since foundation (I Pet 1:20)
- 4. Jesus is seen as slain since foundation (Rev 13:8)
- 5. He's prepared His kingdom for us since foundation (Matt 25:34)
