Session 2: Faith to Walk in the Supernatural—*JC Alzamora*

I. The Gospel, Faith and Miracles

John 6:26-29 - *"Jesus answered them and said, 'Truly, truly, I say to you, you seek Me, not because you saw signs, but because you ate of the loaves and were filled. Do not work for the food which perishes, but for the food which endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you, for on Him the Father, God, has set His seal.' Therefore they said to Him, 'What shall we do, so that we may work the works of God?' Jesus answered and said to them, 'This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent.'"* (NASB)

1. Don't seek God for what He does only. He is more than a provider, healer, savior; He personifies everything good. *Who is He?*

- He is our Father
- He is love
- He is healing
- He is faithful
- He is compassionate
- He is powerful

2. Don't work for food that perishes.

- Heaven is home, not Earth
- Terminal vs. Eternal endures
- Eternal Bread of Life: Jesus
- Jesus gives us this heavenly food
- Father has set His seal on Him

3. This is the work of God:

- Believe in Jesus (representation, radiance of his essence)
- Believe in the One (ultimate source, God: Luke 4, Isaiah 61)
- Believe He was sent (King upon Zion, the Delight of the nations)
- Believe in His power; believe in His name
- Believe in His nature (good)

II. Signs follow those who believe

Mark 16:17-18 - *“These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues; they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”* (NASB)

- His Name is above everything
- The context is: GO and do it!

1. Who do you believe God is?

- Is He good?
- Is He powerful?
- Is He love?
- Is He able?
- Is He here?
- Is He faithful?
- Is He miraculous?

2. Can we trust Him?

- He is the same forever
- He does not lie
- His perfect nature binds Him to goodness

1 Peter 1:6-9 - *“In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials, so that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ; and though you have not seen Him, you love Him, and though you do not see Him now, but believe in Him, you greatly rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, obtaining as the outcome of your faith the salvation of your souls.”* (NASB)

- Though we don't see Him, yet we love Him
- Though we don't see Him NOW, yet we believe in Him
- Greatly rejoicing: Joy and glory

Acts 10:38 - *“You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.”* (NASB)
