SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- SCISSORS
- HOLE PUNCH OR SMALL CLIPS
- STRING
- CARDSTOCK



INSTRUCTIONS:


- PRINT THE SCRIPTURE CARDS DOUBLESIDED ON CARDSTOCK PAPER.
- CUT OUT EACH INDIVIDUAL SCRIPTURE CARD WITH SCISSORS.
- CUT A PIECE OF STRING ROUGHLY 3 FEET LONG.
- IF USING A HOLE PUNCH, PUNCH A HOLE IN THE TOP RIGHT CORNER OF EACH SCRIPTURE CARD. THEN BEGIN ADDING YOUR CARDS ONTO YOUR STRING.
- IF USING CLIPS BEGIN CLIPPING EACH SCRIPTURE CARD ONTO YOUR STRING.
- SPACE EACH SCRIPTURE CARD A FEW INCHES APART WITH THE DAY AND CARD PICTURE FACING OUTWARD.
- EACH DAY DURING DECEMBER, READ THE ADVENT DEVOTIONAL AS A FAMILY AND AFTERWARDS FLIP THAT DAY'S SCRIPTURE CARD OVER TO REVEAL THE KEY VERSE.






