¹¹To illustrate the point further, Jesus told them this story: "A man had two sons.

Unrighteous - not righteous; not upright or virtuous; **wicked**; sinful; evil:

Self-righteousness is accompanied by "indignation and complacency." Synonyms for **self-righteousness** include: sanctimonious, **holier-than-thou**, **self-satisfied**, smug, priggish, pious, moralizing, preachy, superior, and hypocritical. **Self-righteous** is the opposite of **humble**.

The younger son was **Lost in Plain Sight**.

He was **Heavy, Tired, & Fragile**.

Emotional problems usually begin in childhood, and they primarily begin with **unresolved pain**.

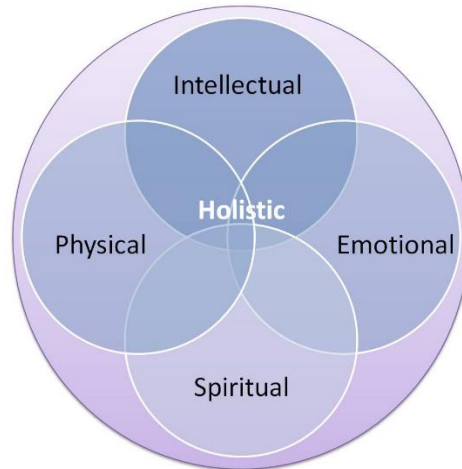
Pain was intended to be our **Teacher** not our **Torturer**



Without Pain you would be **Fearless**, but **Faithless**

“**emotional health** and **spiritual maturity** are **inseparable**. It is not possible to be spiritually mature while remaining emotionally immature.” -Peter Scazzero

The term "**holistic thinking**" refers to a **big picture mentality** in which a person recognizes the interconnectedness of various elements that form larger systems, patterns and objects



Sadly people tend to judge you based off of your **REACTIONS** without ever knowing the **ACTIONS** that birth your **unhealthy response**.

Sometimes you must realize, “**I’m Unhealthy.**”

“**Ignoring our emotions is turning our back on reality**. Listening to our emotions ushers us into reality. **And reality is where we meet God.** . . . Emotions are the language of the soul. They are the cry that gives the heart a voice. . .” — Peter Scazzero, *Emotionally Healthy Spirituality*

The younger son is like many of us, **Saved & Sick**.

Sick Spirit leads to **Sick Mind** which births **Sick Actions**
