¹³ "A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land, and there he wasted all his money in wild living.

Season of Wild Living = Lowered Standards

Lower standards are connected to Wild People.

Luke 15:14 (NLT)

¹⁴ About the time his money ran out, a great famine swept over the land, and he began to starve.

Luke 15:14 (NASB)

¹⁴ "Now when he had spent everything, a severe famine occurred in **that country**, and he began to be impoverished.

Luke 15:15 (NASB)

¹⁵ "So he went and hired himself out to one of the citizens of that country, and he sent him into his fields to feed swine.

Luke 15:15 (NLT)

¹⁵ He **persuaded** a local farmer to hire him, and the man sent him into his fields to feed the pigs.

Luke 15:16 (NLT)

¹⁶ The young man became so hungry that even the pods he was feeding the pigs looked good to him. But no one gave him anything.

Desperation + No Resources/Support = Savage #PMJBeOnIt

Luke 15:17 (NLT)

¹⁷ "When he finally came to his senses, he said to himself, 'At home even the hired servants have food enough to spare, and here I am dying of hunger!

Luke 15:17 (MSG)

¹⁷ '**That brought him to his senses.** He said, 'All those farmhands working for my father sit down to three meals a day, and here I am starving to death.

It's not about Possessions but Position!
