### Luke 15:11-13 (NLT)

<sup>11</sup> To illustrate the point further, Jesus told them this story: “A man had two sons.<sup>12</sup> The younger son told his father, ‘I want my share of your estate now before you die.’ So his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons.<sup>13</sup> “A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land, and there he wasted all his money in wild living.
