> Very Nature (morphe): Essence, nature or character. Who you are at your core.

He made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness." v.7

The glory of the incarnation is that it presents to our adoring gaze not a humanized God or a deified man, but a true God man - one who is all that God is, and at the same time all that man is- one on whose almighty arm we can rest and to whose human sympathy we can appeal.

The decision to become human, and to go all the way along the road of obedience, to the divine plan of salvation, yes all the way to the cross - this decision was not a decision to stop being divine. It was a decision about what it really meant to be divine.
