- 1 If you had a time machine that could only be used once, what point in the future or past would you go to? Why?
- **2 -** Read Matthew 21:1-3. If you were one of the disciples, how would react to this request? Have you ever felt like Jesus was calling you to obey a strange request? How did you respond?
- **3** Read Matthew 21:6. God had a plan for this Donkey 500 years in advance. How have you seen God place and prepare you for His plans? How can you be obedient and step into those plans?
- 4 Read Matthew 21:7-11 When Jesus rode into Jerusalem the crowd treated him as a King. What do you think the crowd expected of him?
- **5** However, Jesus rode a donkey, a symbol of humility and peace, implying Jesus wasn't coming for political or military conquest. Jesus didn't meet the expectations of many of these people.
 - What are some unrealistic expectations we sometimes have of God? What can we do to keep our expectations of God rooted in truth?
- **6** By the end of the week the same crowd would be chanting Crucify him! How do we sometimes proclaim Hosanna, and turn around and shout Crucify soon after?
