- <sup>1</sup> This is a trustworthy saying: 'If someone aspires to be a church leader, he desires an honorable position.' <sup>2</sup> So a church leader must be a man whose life is **above reproach**. He must be **faithful to his wife**. He must **exercise self-control**, **live wisely**, and **have a good reputation**. He must **enjoy having guests in his home**, and he must be **able to teach**. <sup>3</sup> He must **not be a heavy drinker or be violent**. He must be **gentle**, **not quarrelsome**, and **not love money**. <sup>4</sup> He must **manage his own family well**, having children who respect and obey him. <sup>5</sup> For if a man cannot manage his own household, how can he take care of God's church?
  - <sup>6</sup> A church leader must not be **a new believer**, because he might **become proud**, and the devil would cause him to fall. <sup>7</sup> Also, people **outside the church must speak well of him** so that he will not be disgraced and fall into the devil's trap.
  - <sup>8</sup> In the same way, deacons **must be well respected** and **have integrity**. They must **not be heavy drinkers** or **dishonest with money**. <sup>9</sup> They must be committed to the mystery of the faith now revealed and must **live with a clear conscience**. <sup>10</sup> Before they are appointed as deacons, let them be closely examined. If they pass the test, then let them serve as deacons.
  - <sup>11</sup> In the same way, their wives must **be respected** and must **not slander others**. They must **exercise self-control** and **be faithful in everything they do**.
  - <sup>12</sup> A deacon must be **faithful to his wife**, and he must **manage his children** and household well. <sup>13</sup> Those who do well as deacons will be rewarded with respect from others and will have increased confidence in their faith in Christ Jesus."
