- 66 One night during the second year of his reign, Nebuchadnezzar had such disturbing dreams that he couldn't sleep.<sup>2</sup> He called in his magicians, enchanters, sorcerers, and astrologers, and he demanded that they tell him what he had dreamed. As they stood before the king, <sup>3</sup> he said, 'I have had a dream that deeply troubles me, and I must know what it means.'
  - <sup>4</sup> Then the astrologers answered the king in Aramaic, 'Long live the king! Tell us the dream, and we will tell you what it means.'"

So Arioch told him all that had happened. <sup>16</sup> Daniel went at once to see the king and requested more time to tell the king what the dream meant."

66 Then Daniel went home and told his friends Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah what had happened. <sup>18</sup> He urged them to ask the God of heaven to show them his mercy by telling them the secret, so they would not be executed along with the other wise men of Babylon. <sup>19</sup> That night the secret was revealed to Daniel in a vision. Then Daniel praised the God of heaven. <sup>20</sup> He said, 'Praise the name of God forever and ever, for he has all wisdom and power. <sup>21</sup> He controls the course of world events; he removes kings and sets up other kings. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the scholars. <sup>22</sup> He reveals deep and mysterious things and knows what lies hidden in darkness, though he is surrounded by light. <sup>23</sup> I thank and praise you, God of my ancestors, for you have given me wisdom and strength. You have told me what we asked of you and revealed to us what the king demanded.'"
