



- 2 In Romans 15:14-33 Paul shares more personally about why he wrote Romans and what his upcoming travel plans are. After reading these verse how would you describe what is most important in life to Paul?
- **3** Romans 15:7-13 talks a great deal about the relationship between Jewish and Gentile Christians. Why does Paul spend so much time emphasizing the importance of unity between these (and other) groups? See also Ephesians 2:14
- 4 Have you ever been a part of a dis-unified group? If so what was that like?
- 5 When you hear about the importance of "evangelism" what is your first response? How do you relate to Paul's ambition to "make Christ known?"
- 6 What do you see as your biggest hindrance from sharing Christ with others? What can you do to overcome that?
- 7 What is your first response to scriptures likes Matthew 28:19-20 or Isaiah 49:6 and God's priority to be known among the nations? What part do you see yourself playing in fulfilling the great commission described in these verses?
- 8 Share with your group a person, or people, that you believe God might be calling you to share Him with? Pray for each other and opportunities for reach those people.
