So – brief review:

You’re involved with someone that fits our topic.

You want to know how to ‘deal with them’.

Probably should realize How did these people get there?

1. :21-23 Like the Pharisees / unpardonable sin, they knew God but chose vanity & self worship
2. :24 So, God gave them over to impurity – Scene: Analyze This – “why do you have a girlfriend?”

- a. no longer possess themselves sexually in honor as 1 Thes. 4:4
- 3. 25 worshipped the creature, often thru ritual sex (today, clubbing / swapping, pornography etc)
- 4. 26-27 So, God gave them over to degrading passions (homosexuality)
- 5. :28a And in their degrading passions, stopped thinking about God altogether, put Him out of their minds
- 6. :28b-end So, God gave them over to a depraved mind and now we have a nation with

- wall street
- overcrowded prison system
- unelected illegal government lying to us to get nanotechnology in us
- child sex trafficking
- lust to murder babies
- sexual perversion of all kinds
- open Satanism

That nation is made of people both at the street level all the way up to the president's office

- People who are lost.
- People who have been given over, ruined their conscience, and no longer see
- No longer able to recognize truth when they see it
- Like Pharisees, they have the choice of an apple pie or a cow pie and choose the cow pie thinking it's food

NOW the question is how do you reach someone like that? What do you say to someone like that?

How about, "Jesus died for your sins, stop being gay." ?

When we say, "Gospel" – what do you think of?

Discuss. because 'church culture' has narrowed our thinking

What is the gospel? Not the memorized church words, what is the real gospel? The big picture?

Discuss – a lot of different ways one could take this

What is the core message of the gospel?

Does the core message of the gospel change?

Is that "the gospel" in total?

What does 'gospel' mean? Let's take a detour.

euangélion = gospel;

1. Good news / good tidings; +
2. A reward for good tidings

Who was the first person to use this word in the Bible?

Mt 4:23 ¶ Jesus was going throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people.

Did Matthew's readers go, "Hey, what's that word mean? Why ya keep tryin' ta say that word?"

NO It is a secular word used long before Matthew.

1st Century AD: Josephus – Jewish Wars 2.420

Now this terrible message [that a rebellion was brewing] was good news [εὐαγγέλιον] to Florus; and because his design was to have a war kindled

9BC: Famous Priene Inscription, about the dedication of a temple by Alexander to Athena Polias

and since the birthday of the god [τοῦ θεοῦ] Augustus was the beginning of the good tidings [εὐαγγέλιον] for the world that came by reason of him

5th Century B.C.: Aristophanes in The Knights (Equites) lines 647 and 656

“You! You... Councillors! I’ve got good news [εὐαγγέλια — see the Greek] for you!” I said to them. “News that are so good, I want to make sure that I’m the first to announce them to you. It’s the price of sardines, folks! It’s the best it’s ever been since the outbreak of the war!”

So if Gospel means the core message we discussed, how thick would the bible be?

The gospel is much bigger given in the Word, and each distinct element of the periphery of the wider picture points you to the core.

When we say ‘share the gospel’ – this is what we mean

- Start outside – where that person is,
- Work your way to the core

So where do we start, outside?

Well, Every situation is different.

- Some are completely happy in their sin; dead while they live
- Some are enslaved, know it, and don’t know how to get out.
- Some don’t see how they are in sin at all, you are the one who is out of place; mockers

Some are entangled in physical, chemical addictions

Others, in self-loathing & hatred can’t really relate to the above

Did Jesus say the same thing to everyone? Heal everyone the same way?

Was His interaction with Nicodemus the same as it was the group of Pharisees?

- Or the woman caught in the very act of adultery?
- Or the rich young ruler?

Everyone is in a different place, different needs, different viewpoints

(that’s why Paul says)

1 Cor 9: 19 For though I am free from all *men*, I have made myself a slave to all, so that I may win more. ²⁰ To the Jews I became as a Jew, so that I might win Jews; to those who are under the Law, as under the Law though not being myself under the Law, so that I might win those who are under the Law; ²¹ to those who are without law, as without law, though not being without the law of God but under the law of Christ, so that I might win those who are without law. ²² To the weak I became weak, that I might win the weak; I have become all things to all men, so that I may by all means save some. ²³ I do all things for the sake of the gospel, so that I may become a fellow partaker of it.

Why isn’t there a magic formula to use?

How are we supposed to know what to say in a given instance?

How important is it?
