- Christians should prepare for the End Times: 'Ignore it at your own peril'
- Urged Christians to 'be ready for the return of Christ'
- of world events "There's no excuse for us, if we read the Bible, to be surprised. Because the Bible tells us that this is going to happen,"
- I believe that Christians really need to stay glued to the Scripture and not get too far away from the truth because it's pretty precarious right now.
 - We uncover the lies that make up our world system SO THAT Christians can see EXACTLY what it is they're so in love with that keeps them out of the bible. (it's not a time issue, it's a love issue)
- "The Bible says, 'Be careful that no man deceives you.' Well, we live in a time when the truth is almost gone, and nobody knows what to do with that," he said. "And then the Bible talks about wars and rumors of wars and all kinds of sickness and pestilence, and we just went through the COVID experience. It's the first worldwide pandemic that I've ever been a part of, and maybe the first one that was totally worldwide."
- concluding, "You can ignore it all you want to, it's going to happen anyway," he said. "If you do what I do, you meet a lot of people who think that because they don't believe it, that makes it untrue. Well, it doesn't matter whether you believe it or not, it's true anyway, and you better wake up to it. Because if you don't, one day, you're going to experience it. ... You can ignore it if you want to, but it's you do it at your own peril."

Pr 1:4 To give prudence to the naive, To the youth knowledge and discretion, Prudence – ormah = craftiness, Example: Joshua 9 - Gibeon after Joshua conquered Ai and Jericho. in self-preservation - Dressed down & put on worn out sandles, clothes, worn out saddle bags – said, "We've traveled from a long way away, make a covenant with us" Israelites didn't ask God about it Got tricked (they *craftily* made this covenant) – same word Can be used for evil, Can be used for good (this craftiness) Mt 10:16 ¶ "Behold, I send you out as sheep in the midst of wolves; so be shrewd as serpents and innocent as doves.

How does God's word give you sort of reverse craftiness?

- Bad bad says the buyer
- do not be unequally yoked
- Rachel hid 'gods' she didn't want Jacob to find, around her and said she was on her period & couldn't get up
