What did he do? Tentmaker?

Priest class, Direct descendant of Aaron (Ez.7:1-5 genealogy)

Ezra was likely the pen-man of both Ezra and Nehemiah

Not quoted in NT

Also most believed to have penned both Chronicles (see)

2 Chron 36: 22 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD spoken by the mouth of Jeremiah might be accomplished, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and put it also in writing, saying, 23 Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, All the kingdoms of the earth hath the LORD God of heaven given me; and he hath charged me to build him an house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Who is there among you of all his people? The LORD his God be with him, and let him go up.

Ez 1: 1 Now in the first year of Cyrus king of Persia, that the word of the LORD by the mouth of Jeremiah might be fulfilled, the LORD stirred up the spirit of Cyrus king of Persia, that he made a proclamation throughout all his kingdom, and put it also in writing, saying, 2 Thus saith Cyrus king of Persia, The LORD God of heaven hath given me all the kingdoms of the earth; and he hath charged me to build him an house at Jerusalem, which is in Judah. 3 Who is there among you of all his people? his God be with him, and let him go

He wrote in the 3rd person thru Chronicles up to Ezra 7 likely quoting memoirs from Ez1-6, where he switches to 1st person mid chap7,

Ezra led the second return from Persia (ca. 458 B.C.)

Ezra and Nehemiah were contemporaries.

Zerubbabel also – Governor of Judah, lineage of David

Who were his other contemporaries?

Rulers:

- King Cyrus
- Darius
- Xerxes – (Ahasuerus); where have we seen him? – Esther * Mordecai
 - “Esther” Took place between events of Chapters 6 and 7 of Ezra
- Artaxerxes I

Prophets:

- Haggai
- Zechariah
- Ez 5: ¹ Then the prophets, Haggai the prophet, and Zechariah the son of Iddo, prophesied unto the Jews that *were* in Judah and Jerusalem in the name of the God of Israel, *even* unto them.
- Daniel is not a contemporary, though he mentions Cyrus and Darius – these are in his time. Ezra historically mentions them and is 80 years after Daniel m/l

Adversaries

- Sanballat – Governor of Samaria, a horonite
 - (Lindsey Graham et.al)
- Tobiah – Descendent of Lot (ammonite); rich guy & political insider, until kicked out by Nehemiah
 - Bill Gates
- Geshem – Arabic ruler of trade routes
 - George Soros
- Rehum – Persian official
 - Pam Bondi or Kash Patel

Ezra picks up where 2Chron leaves off.

What were the main events of 2 Chronicles?

Chap 1-8

- Solomon takes over, asks for wisdom
- builds the 1st temple w/ \$ David got for him,
- Brings the ark into the temple
- Temple worship / God’s glory in the temple
- Solomon builds buildings

Chap 9-13

- Rehoboam succeeds Solomon, causes a church split / keeps Judah and Benjamin
- Civil war w/ Jeroboam former solomonic advisor / 10 Israeli tribes

Chap 14 – end

- More of kings that did evil in God's site, Fewer that did good (11/8 with Abijah nothing said?)

They end up in Assyrian captivity, right? Nebuchadnezzar?

God judged them. Jerusalem was destroyed, the Temple was demolished, and the people of Judah were taken into captivity by the Babylonians

Jer 25:11 KJV - 11 And this whole land shall be a desolation, and an astonishment; and these nations shall serve the king of Babylon seventy years.

But after this, God called His people back home.

As there had been 3 waves of deportation from Israel into Babylon (605 B.C., 597 B.C., and 586 B.C.), so there were actually 3 returns to Jerusalem over a 9-decade span.

Zerubbabel first returned in 538 B.C. (Ezra 1-6)

followed by Ezra, who led the second return in 458 B.C. (Ezra 7-10 end)

Nehemiah did likewise 13 years later, in 445 B.C.

Complete uncontested political autonomy, however, never returned.

The prophets Haggai and Zechariah preached during Zerubbabel's time, about 520 B.C. and following.

Whewee! that's enough for one day.

What were they doing in captivity in the first place?

Israel was in a multitude of sins

God said if you won't listen to me here, I'll humble you so you are teachable in a foreign land.

Isaiah 28: ⁹ Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand doctrine? *them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts.* ¹⁰ For precept *must be* upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, *and* there a little: ¹¹ For with stammering lips and another tongue will he speak to this people. ¹² To whom he said, This *is* the rest *wherewith* ye may cause the weary to rest; and this *is* the refreshing: yet they would not hear. ¹³ But the word of the LORD was unto them precept upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, *and* there a little; that they might go, and fall backward, and be broken, and snared, and taken.

That's contextually about Israel. What about us?

Jeremiah 18: 9 And if at any time I declare concerning a nation or a kingdom that I will build and plant it, 10 and if it does evil in my sight, not listening to my voice, then I will relent of the good that I had intended to do to it.

Just read Isaiah and Jeremiah

Isaiah 1:4 Ah sinful nation, a people laden with iniquity, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward.
