96 Years of Church History

- 1915: A small group of people began to meet for Bible study at Marshburn Hill School, where the church cemetery is now.
- 1925: Central Baptist Church was organized with 26 charter members, "Centrally" located between four other local Baptist churches.
- 1926: The church members purchased the two-room school house and four acres of land.
- 1927: They renovated the original building and through the years added five additional classrooms, a porch, and a steeple with a bell which is currently located in the courtyard.
- 1946: Lights were installed, and the church had electricity for the first time!
- 1968: Additional land was purchased for a church building, and the first service in the new sanctuary (Bldg C) was held Aug 3, 1969.
- 1984: A new sanctuary which is currently a Prayer Chapel (Bldg B) was built. The first service was held there on Dec 23.
- 1994: The Fellowship/Educational Building was completed (Bldg D).
- 2001: Central partnered with several other local churches, the Raleigh Baptist Association, and the Baptist State Convention of NC to plant a church in Clayton, The Church at Clayton Crossings.
- 2002: Central began offering annual summer family mission trips, and our families have been to NC, VT, KY, PA, MD, and SC.
- 2004: The church received the office building (Bldg E) as a donation.
- 2005: Central purchased an 8.42 acre track of land across the street from the church for future ministry expansion.
- 2006: Central established a missions partnership with the Independent Baptist Mission for Asians, Pastor John Quizon.
- 2008: Central established a missions partnership with Grace Baptist Church and Heartbeat Bible Institute in Cambodia, Pastor Francis Landingin.
- 2008: Central acquired a 29.7 acre farm and fishing pond on Eagle Rock Road and has made upgrades for use as an outdoor ministry venue.

- 2009: Construction on the Worship Recreation Center with a Preschool Suite (Bldg A) was completed.
- 2010: Central opened a full-day, weekday preschool as an outreach to the community with five staff members and 17 children.
- 2011: Central began offering annual summer student mission trips and has sent out our students to NC, PA, MD, GA and Mexico.
- 2012: The Worship/Gym area was outfitted for use, and the first worship service was held in this new building on Sept 9.
- 2015: Central established a church planting partnership with Graffiti Ministries in Baltimore, Pastor Charlie Brown.
- 2019: The Academy of Performing Arts at Central opened as an outreach to the community offering instrumental, voice, and recording sessions for the community.
- 2019: Central began supporting First Priority School Ministries.
- 2021: Renovations were completed on the Prayer Chapel and The Academy of Performing Arts wing (Bldg B).
- 2021: The Central Sports Academy opened as an outreach ministry offering lessons and clinics for the community.
