Message Title: The Call To Intercessory Prayer
Message Text: 1 Timothy 2:1-3 & Genesis 18:16
Scripture Memory: 1 Timothy 2:1-3 (NIV) *I urge, then, first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone— for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior.*

Main Idea: God calls us to become intercessory prayer warriors, for both the righteous and wicked of the earth.

- 1) Our foremost and greatest work in ministry is to pray for others because the power of the gospel in the world is dependent on the prayers of God's people in the church.
- 2) God wants us to become intercessory prayer warriors, that is, believers who wrestle in prayer for others.

How do we become intercessory prayer warriors?

- A) We must desire to develop the closest and most intimate walk with the Lord.
- B) We must focus on God's character and plan for our life.
- C) We must sympathize the pain of God's heart over the wickedness of mankind.
- D) We must stand humbly before the Lord in prayer, boldly appealing to His justice.
- E) We must pray our concerns transparently asking God for divine intervention and rescue.
