Romans 12:1-2 KJVS

1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that GOOD, and ACCEPTABLE, and PERFECT, WILL OF GOD.

GOOD: *useful, well, beneficial, pleasant, agreeable, joyful, happy, excellent, distinguished, upright, honourable.*

ACCEPTABLE: *well pleasing.*

PERFECT: *brought to its end, finished. Wanting nothing necessary to completeness. Full grown and mature. COMPLETION.*

Romans 8:6-8 KJVS

6 FOR TO BE CARNALLY MINDED IS DEATH; BUT TO BE SPIRITUALLY MINDED IS LIFE AND PEACE.

PEACE: *quietness, rest, a state of national tranquility, exemption from rage and havoc of war, peace between individuals, security, safety, prosperity...*

7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.

8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Opportunity has an expiration date and a shelf life.

According to Numbers chapter 14 a moment missed may not show up again until 40 years later. WOW.

Some moments only come once in a lifetime.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 KJVS

1 To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven:

2 A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted;

3 A time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up;

4 A time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance;

5 A time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;

6 A time to get, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away;

7 A time to rend, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;

8 A time to love, and a time to hate; a time of war, and a time of peace.

11 Signs You're In Transition

1. *God speaks to you from his word.*
2. *You have no peace and are dissatisfied.*
3. *You become Burden to find the answer.*
4. *You are looking to escape from where you are.*
5. *You are excited to visit other places.*
6. *Doors begin to close.*
7. *Close relationships begin to feel distant.*
8. *You begin to question what is my purpose and why am I here.*
9. *Resources begin to dry up.*
10. *God begins to use different things to grab your attention.*
11. *What use to work in the last season don't work anymore.*

1 Chronicles 12:32 KJVS

32 And of THE CHILDREN OF ISSACHAR, WHICH WERE MEN THAT HAD UNDERSTANDING OF THE TIMES, TO KNOW WHAT ISRAEL OUGHT TO DO; the heads of them were two hundred; and all their brethren were at their commandment.

1 Chronicles 12:32 NLT

32 From the tribe of Issachar, there were 200 leaders of the tribe with their relatives. ALL THESE MEN UNDERSTOOD THE SIGNS OF THE TIMES AND KNEW THE BEST COURSE FOR ISRAEL TO TAKE.

THE CARNAL MIND AT WORK

Numbers 14:1-12 NLT

1 Then the whole community began weeping aloud, and they cried all night.

2 Their voices rose in a great chorus of protest against Moses and Aaron. "If only we had died in Egypt, or even here in the wilderness!" they complained.

3 "Why is the LORD taking us to this country only to have us die in battle? Our wives and our little ones will be carried off as plunder! Wouldn't it be better for us to return to Egypt?"

4 THEN THEY PLOTTED AMONG THEMSELVES, "LET'S CHOOSE A NEW LEADER AND GO BACK TO EGYPT!"

5 Then Moses and Aaron fell face down on the ground before the whole community of Israel.

6 Two of the men who had explored the land, Joshua son of Nun and Caleb son of Jephunneh, tore their clothing.

7 They said to all the people of Israel, "The land we traveled through and explored is a wonderful land!

8 AND IF THE LORD IS PLEASED WITH US, HE WILL BRING US SAFELY INTO THAT LAND AND GIVE IT TO US. IT IS A RICH LAND FLOWING WITH MILK AND HONEY.

9 Do not rebel against the LORD, and don't be afraid of the people of the land. They are only helpless prey to us! They have no protection, but the LORD is with us! Don't be afraid of them!"

10 But the whole community began to talk about stoning Joshua and Caleb. Then the glorious presence of the LORD appeared to all the Israelites at the Tabernacle.

11 And the LORD said to Moses, "How long will these people treat me with contempt? Will they never believe me, even after all the miraculous signs I have done among them?"

12 I will disown them and destroy them with a plague. Then I will make you into a nation greater and mightier than they are!"

JUDGEMENT COMES SWIFTLY

Numbers 14:32-37 KJVS

32 But as for you, your carcasses, they shall fall in this wilderness.

33 And your children shall wander in the wilderness forty years, and bear your whoredoms, until your carcasses be wasted in the wilderness.

34 After the number of the days in which ye searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year, shall ye bear your iniquities, even forty years, and ye shall know my breach of promise.

35 I the Lord have said, I will surely do it unto all this evil congregation, that are gathered together against me: in this wilderness they shall be consumed, and there they shall die.

36 And the men, which Moses sent to search the land, who...

returned, and made all the congregation to murmur against him, by bringing up a slander upon the land,

37 Even those men that did bring up the evil report upon the land, died by the plague before the Lord.

DRIVEN BY THE CARNAL MIND

Numbers 14:39-45 KJVS

39 And Moses told these sayings unto all the children of Israel: and the people mourned greatly.

40 And they rose up early in the morning, and gat them up into the top of the mountain, saying, Lo, we be here, and will go up unto the place which the Lord hath promised: for we have sinned.

41 And Moses said, Wherefore now do ye transgress the commandment of the Lord ? but it shall not prosper.

42 Go not up, for the Lord is not among you; that ye be not smitten before your enemies.

43 For the Amalekites and the Canaanites are there before you, and ye shall fall by the sword: because ye are turned away from the Lord, therefore the Lord will not be with you.

44 But they presumed to go up unto the hill top: nevertheless the ark of the covenant of the Lord, and Moses, departed not out of the camp.

45 Then the Amalekites came down, and the Canaanites which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and discomfited them, even unto Hormah.
