3. THE DAY OF MIRACLES IS PAST

Some people, who came from certain religious backgrounds, still believe this false teaching. There never was a day of miracles, but there always was and is a God of miracles.

Hebrews 13:8 KJVS

8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever.

Matthew 28:18-20 KJVS

18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

19 Go ye therefore, and TEACH ALL NATIONS, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

20 TEACHING THEM TO OBSERVE ALL THINGS WHATSOEVER I HAVE COMMANDED YOU: AND, LO, I AM WITH YOU ALWAYS, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

Mark 16:15-20 KJVS

15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; **THEY SHALL LAY HANDS ON THE SICK, AND THEY SHALL RECOVER.**

19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.

20 And they went forth, and preached everywhere, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

4. HEALING IS ONLY FOR SOME, NOT FOR ALL

Matthew 8:16-17 KJVS

16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and HEALED ALL THAT WERE SICK:

17 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Matthew 9:35 KJVS

35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and HEALING EVERY SICKNESS AND EVERY DISEASE AMONG THE PEOPLE.

Luke 6:19 KJVS

19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: FOR THERE WENT VIRTUE OUT OF HIM, AND HEALED THEM ALL.

Acts 10:34-35,38 KJVS

34 Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons:

35 But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him.

38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and HEALING ALL that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Matthew 12:15 KJVS

15 But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and GREAT MULTITUDES FOLLOWED HIM, AND HE HEALED THEM ALL;

Mark 6:56 KJVS

56 And whithersoever he entered, into villages, or cities, or country, they laid the sick in the streets, and besought him that they might touch if it were but the border of his garment: and AS MANY AS TOUCHED HIM WERE MADE WHOLE.

Acts 5:14-16 KJVS

14 And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.

15 Insomuch that they brought forth the sick into the streets, and laid them on beds and couches, that at the least the shadow of Peter passing by might overshadow some of them.

16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: AND THEY WERE HEALED EVERYONE.

5. I'M NOT GOOD ENOUGH FOR GOD TO HEAL ME

Isaiah 53:4-5 KJVS

4 Surely, he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; AND WITH HIS STRIPES WE ARE HEALED.

1 Peter 2:24 KJVS

24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

2 Corinthians 5:21 KJVS

21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

1 John 1:9 KJVS

9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Ephesians 1:6 KJVS

6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

Romans 5:1 KJVS

1 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

Romans 8:1 KJVS

1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Romans 8:17 KJVS

17 AND IF CHILDREN, THEN HEIRS; HEIRS OF GOD, AND JOINT-HEIRS WITH CHRIST; if so be that we suffer with him, that we may be also glorified together.
