RIDICULOUS BENEFITS OF SPEAKING IN TONGUES

Job 28:7-12 KJVS

- 7 There is a path which no fowl knoweth, and which the vulture's eye hath not seen:
- 8 The lion's whelps have not trodden it, nor the fierce lion passed by it.
- 9 He putteth forth his hand upon the rock; he overturneth the mountains by the roots.
- 10 He cutteth out rivers among the rocks; and his eye seeth every precious thing.
- 11 He bindeth the floods from overflowing; and the thing that is hid bringeth he forth to light.
- **12** But where shall wisdom be found? and where is the place of understanding?

The MYSTERIES of God (OT Examples of Tongues)

As I was getting ready to put my notes together for the broadcast the Holy Spirit began to bring the Scriptures to my mind to give me Old Testament examples of what it means to pray directly to God speaking mysteries. Here are the Old Testament examples that the Holy Spirit brought to my mind:

Pharaoh's dream could not be interpreted by the magicians, But Joseph, a man of the Spirit of God, received the interpretation.

Genesis 41:8 KJVS

8 And it came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the wise men thereof: and Pharaoh told them his dream; but there was none that could interpret them unto Pharaoh.

Nebuchadnezzar's dreams could not be interpreted by the magicians and astrologers. But Daniel, a man of the Spirit of God, received the interpretation.

Daniel 2:1-11 KJVS

- 1 And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.
- 2 Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to shew the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king.
- 3 And the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my spirit was troubled to know the dream.
- 4 Then spake the Chaldeans to the king in Syriack, O king, live forever: tell thy servants the dream, and we will shew the interpretation.

- 5 The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, The thing is gone from me: if ye will not make known unto me the dream, with the interpretation thereof, ye shall be cut in pieces, and your houses shall be made a dunghill.
- 6 But if ye shew the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honor: therefore shew me the dream, and the interpretation thereof.
- 7 They answered again and said, Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will shew the interpretation of it.
- 8 The king answered and said, I know of certainty that ye would gain the time, because ye see the thing is gone from me.
- 9 But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, there is but one decree for you: for ye have prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that ye can shew me the interpretation thereof.
- 10 The Chaldeans answered before the king, and said, There is not a man upon the earth that can shew the king's matter: therefore there is no king, lord, nor ruler, that asked such things at any magician, or astrologer, or Chaldean.
- 11 And it is a rare thing that the king requireth, and there is none other that can shew it before the king, except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh.

Daniel 2:16-23 KJVS

- 16 Then Daniel went in, and desired of the king that he would give him time, and that he would shew the king the interpretation.
- 17 Then Daniel went to his house, and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions:
- 18 That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.
- 19 THEN WAS THE SECRET REVEALED UNTO DANIEL IN A NIGHT VISION. THEN DANIEL BLESSED THE GOD OF HEAVEN.
- 20 Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his:
- 21 And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:
- 22 He revealeth the DEEP and SECRET THINGS: he knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him.
- 23 I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast now made known unto us the king's matter.

None of the astrologers were able to interpret God's handwriting on the wall, but Daniel, a man of the Spirit of God, was able to give the interpretation.

Daniel 5:10-12, 15 KJVS

- 10 Now the queen, by reason of the words of the king and his lords, came into the banquet house: and the queen spake and said, O king, live forever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:
- 11 There is a man in thy kingdom, in whom is the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of thy father LIGHT and UNDERSTANDING and WISDOM, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar thy father, the king, I say, thy father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, and soothsayers;
- 12 Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and shewing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will shew the interpretation.
- 15 And now the wise men, the astrologers, have been brought in before me, that they should read this writing, and make known unto me the interpretation thereof: but they could not shew the interpretation of the thing:

When we pray in tongues, we speak mysteries to God, and he speaks mysteries to us. No devil in hell can understand what is being discussed between you and God until God gives you the understanding, and you begin to declare it in... ...your known tongue. And by then it's too late for the devil to do anything about it. I am blown away.

1 Corinthians 14:2 KJVS

2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.

MYSTERY: a hidden or secret thing, not obvious to the understanding, a hidden purpose or counsel. The secret counsels which govern God dealing with the righteous, which are hidden from the ungodly and wicked men but plain to the godly.

1 Corinthians 14:4 KJVS

4 He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself; but he that prophesieth edifieth the church.

1 Corinthians 14:13-15 KJVS

- 13 Wherefore let him that speaketh in an unknown tongue pray that he may interpret.
- 14 For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful.
- 15 What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also.

1 Corinthians 2:6-8 KJVS

6 Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world...

...that come to nought:

- **7** But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:
- 8 Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

1 Corinthians 2:9-14 KJVS

- 9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.
- 10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, THE DEEP THINGS OF GOD.
- 11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
- 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.
- 13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
- 14 But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: NEITHER CAN HE KNOW THEM, because they are spiritually discerned.

Deuteronomy 29:29 KJVS

29 The secret things belong unto the Lord our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law.

The Navajo Code

Navajo code talkers helped to secure the victory during World War 2. The Japanese could not crack the Navajo codes, and therefore, Japan was defeated. The Navajo code talkers who Joined the marines were able to send coded messages that left the Japanese scratching their heads because they did not know what was being said. Romans 8:26-28 KJVS

26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

27 And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

The hidden mystery is when we are speaking in unknown...

...tongues to God. The mystery is revealed when God grants us the interpretation of the mysteries the Holy Spirit is praying through us.

Matthew 13:11 KJVS

11 He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given.
