- 2. The Red Sea, 14:1012
- 3. The bitter waters of Marah, 15 22-27
- 4. The time of manna, 16:2-3
- 5. The time of the thirst, 17:1-7

The Complaint Cycle

- 1. abundance from God
- 2. expectation of More
- 3. Dissapointment with Less
- 4. Complaints over circumstances
- 5. Provision from God

Exodus 17 Observations

- 1. They are exactly where God wants them to be
- 2. Their complaining has <u>escalated</u>
- 3. Moses fears for his life
- 4. God reaffirms Moses' authority and leadership
- 5. "strike the rock" & waterfall come out
- 6. Moses created a memorial
