# The Opportunity to Influence Provides a New Level of Meaning and Purpose

### A. Elijah's Predicament

Chapter 17 - Elijah appears on scene and announces a <u>Drought</u>.

Chapter 18 - Elijah has a Confrontation.

Chapter 19 - 👃

Wicked queen and king are after Elijah-- vs 1

Vs 3 - runs

Vs 4 - isolates himself and prays to die

Elijah doesn't seem to be in any shape to be influencing anyone else

#### **Observations**

- 1. Elijah is not thinking <u>Realistically</u> or <u>Clearly</u>.
- 2. Elijah <u>Separates</u> himself from <u>Relationships</u> that strengthen.
- 3. Elijah was caught in the aftermath of a great Victory.
- 4. Elijah is <u>Physically</u> exausted and <u>Emotionally</u> spent.
- 5. Elijah submitted to the beast of <u>Set-pity</u>.

# B. God's care of His prophet.

- Took care of his physical <u>Needs</u>.
- 2. Communicates wisely with Elijah
  - God began with a **Question**.
  - God provides an <u>Object lesson</u> rather than a lecture.
  - God allows Elijah to express his <u>Feelings</u>.
  - God assures Elijah of his <u>Place</u> and <u>Purpose</u>.
