Individuality is discovering who you're meant to be so you can make a difference.



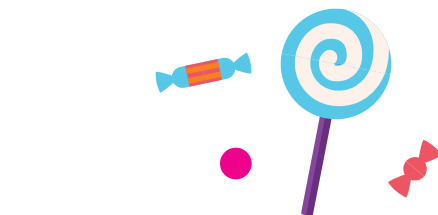
