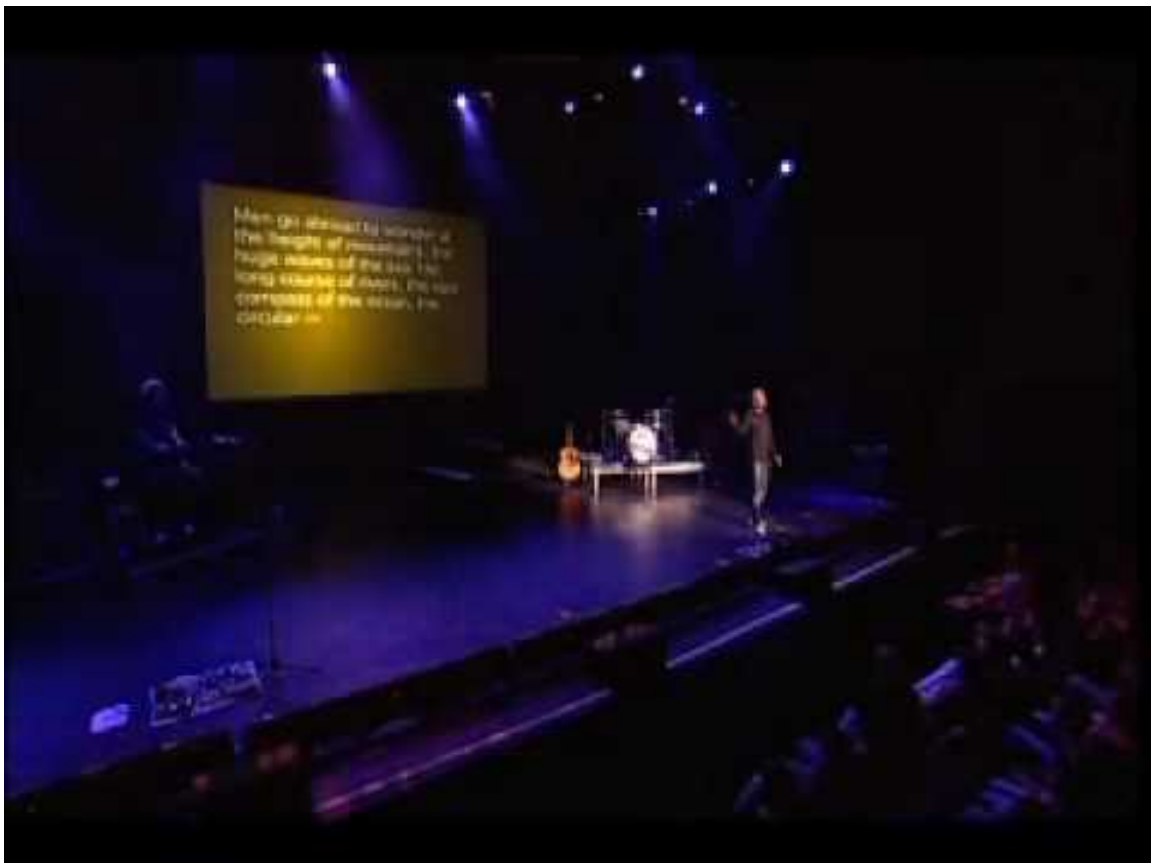


Read [Genesis 1](#)

**Psalm 19:1-6** “The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard. Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them he has set a tent for the sun, which comes out like a bridegroom leaving his chamber, and, like a strong man, runs its course with joy. ### **LOOK UP AND WITHIN**





Laminins are a family of glycoproteins of the extracellular matrix of all animals. They are major components of the basal lamina, the protein network foundation for most cells and organs.

Skeptics turned to Snopes regarding Laminin:

- “The structure of laminin antedates by many thousands of years traditional Christian accounts of the life of Jesus. A cross-like shape is a very simple structure that is commonly found in elements created naturally or accidentally. It is uncertain whether the form of the original crucifixion device was a stake, a T-shape, or the familiar cross of modern Christian iconography.



One could find the shape of laminin to be reminiscent of a variety of common symbols aside from the cross. Some viewers say it reminds them more of a caduceus" (medical symbol).

- "And when the illustration is returned to its original orientation, many liken it to the appearance of a sword."
- "Perhaps most important, molecular diagrams like the one used here are generally intended to represent those structures in ways that make them easy for humans to conceptualize and work with, not to be exact reproductions of the molecules' actual visual appearances."
- "In other images of an actual laminin molecule, it looks more like a mermaid than a cross."

"Discussions about whether or not nature evinces signs of a purposeful (Christian) creator are theological/scientific debates that can (and do) fill volumes, so we'll just note a few items to consider:"

1. "The structure of laminin antedates by many thousands of years traditional Christian accounts of the life of Jesus." (They have it backwards 😏)
2. "A cross-like shape is a very simple structure that is commonly found in elements created naturally or accidentally." (Remember **Romans 1**? - so men are without excuse)

## GOD SPOKE!

- Even the rocks will cry out: Jesus replied, “I tell you, . . . if they keep quiet, the stones will cry out” (Luke 19:40). What did Jesus mean by this statement? Did He mean that the rocks would literally start shouting praises to the Lord? Most likely, no. The expression the stones will cry out seems to be proverbial and isn’t to be understood as a literal statement. The meaning seems to be that it is more likely that the impossible would happen than for the King of kings to enter His capital city without honor. Is this just Jesus speaking in parable form? Or, may he be referring to God’s -and thereby His- glory in all thing made by him, even an inanimate rock.
  - The similarities of light and sound: both are a type of frequency and travel in wavelengths. Sound much slower and light much faster. Light has no mass but emits electromagnetic pulse; conversely, sound has no EMP but can push, or carry mass (think loud base).
