

- ▶ What was prophesied then is being realized now.
- ▶ It is unfolding right now. The world calls it coincidence, historians refer to it as patterns.
- ▶ The original Hebrew scriptures calls it prophecy.
- ▶ Moses was more than a deliverer, he was also a prophet.
- ▶ Moses prophesied this About 3400 years ago and about 1400 years before Jesus.
- ▶ There are 5 prophecies that were told by Moses that would happen simultaneously.
- ▶ They were prophesied to happen in the latter days.

### **Prophecy #1: The Lord Will Scatter You**

**Deuteronomy 28:64-68** “And the Lord will scatter you among all peoples, from one end of the earth to the other, and there you shall serve other gods of wood and stone, which neither you nor your fathers have known. And among these nations you shall find no respite, and there shall be no resting place for the sole of your foot, but the Lord will give you there a trembling heart and failing eyes and a languishing soul. Your life shall hang in doubt before you. Night and day you shall be in dread and have no assurance of your life. In the morning you shall say, ‘If only it were evening!’ and at evening you shall say, ‘If only it were morning!’ because of the dread that your heart shall feel, and the sights that your eyes shall see. And the Lord will bring you back in ships to Egypt, a journey that I promised that you should never make again; and there you shall offer yourselves for sale to your enemies as male and female slaves, but there will be no buyer.”

**Deuteronomy 28:1-14** “And if you faithfully obey the voice of the Lord your God, being careful to do all his commandments that I command you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, if you obey the voice of the Lord your God. Blessed shall you be in the city, and blessed shall you be in the field. Blessed shall be the fruit of your womb and the fruit of your ground and the fruit of your cattle, the increase of your herds and the young of your flock. Blessed shall be your basket and your kneading bowl. Blessed shall you be when you come in, and blessed shall you be when you go out. “The Lord will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before you. They shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways. The Lord will command the blessing on you in your barns and in all that you undertake. And he will bless you in the land that the Lord your God is giving you. The Lord will establish you as a people holy to himself, as he has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the Lord your God and walk in his ways.

And all the peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the name of the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you. And the Lord will make you abound in prosperity, in the fruit of your



womb and in the fruit of your livestock and in the fruit of your ground, within the land that the Lord swore to your fathers to give you. The Lord will open to you his good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands. And you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you shall only go up and not down, if you obey the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you today, being careful to do them, and if you do not turn aside from any of the words that I command you today, to the right hand or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them.”

- ▶ Scatter here means to scatter with force.

### **Prophecy #2: You Will Rebel**

**Deuteronomy 29:1** “For I know that after my death you will surely act corruptly and turn aside from the way that I have commanded you. And in the days to come evil will befall you, because you will do what is evil in the sight of the Lord, provoking him to anger through the work of your hands.”

**Deuteronomy 32:15-17** “But Jeshurun grew fat, and kicked; you grew fat, stout, and sleek; then he forsook God who made him and scoffed at the Rock of his salvation. They stirred him to jealousy with strange gods; with abominations they provoked him to anger. They sacrificed to demons that were not God, to gods they had never known,…”

- ▶ Acharit Hayamin — The latter day’s eschatological assurance  
What we are seeing today isn’t random, it was prophesied.

**Deuteronomy 32:36** “For the Lord will vindicate his people and have compassion on his servants when he sees that their power is gone and there is none remaining, bond or free.”

- ▶ Corruption reaches a peak, then judgement, then restoration

### **Prophecy #3: The Promise Of Yeshua**

**Deuteronomy 18:18** “I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him.”



From among their brothers like you:

- A mediator
- A law giver
- A deliverer
- A prophet
- One who spoke face to face
- A shepherd
- Moses mediated the OT, Jesus establishes the NT
- Moses lifted up a serpent Jesus was lifted up
- One who performed signs and wonders
- A suffering leader who was rejected by his own

**Deuteronomy 34:10-12** “And there has not arisen a prophet since in Israel like Moses, whom the Lord knew face to face, none like him for all the signs and the wonders that the Lord sent him to do in the land of Egypt, to Pharaoh and to all his servants and to all his land, and for all the mighty power and all the great deeds of terror that Moses did in the sight of all Israel.”

**Hebrews 1:1-4** “Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as much superior to angels as the name he has inherited is more excellent than theirs.”

**Hebrews 3:1-3** “Therefore, holy brothers, you who share in a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession, who was faithful to him who appointed him, just as Moses also was faithful in all God's house. For Jesus has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses—as much more glory as the builder of a house has more honor than the house itself.”

### **What does Moses say about the NT?**

**Deuteronomy 30:6** “And the Lord your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your offspring, so that you will love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.”



**Jeremiah 31:31-34** “Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the Lord. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, ‘Know the Lord,’ for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the Lord. For I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.”

### **The warning of not heeding the prophet:**

**Deuteronomy 18:17-19** “And the Lord said to me, ‘They are right in what they have spoken. I will raise up for them a prophet like you from among their brothers. And I will put my words in his mouth, and he shall speak to them all that I command him. And whoever will not listen to my words that he shall speak in my name, I myself will require it of him.’”

### **Prophecy #4: The Rage Of The Nations**

This is more than political disagreement or discontent, this is rage. Total confusion.

**Deuteronomy 32:21** “They have made me jealous with what is no god; they have provoked me to anger with their idols. So I will make them jealous with those who are no people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation.”

- ▶ The world has begun to worship that which is not God. It is demonic!
- ▶ When this happens they become what they worship.
- ▶ They become irrational.
- ▶ Truth is called hate, good is evil, biological reality is called bigotry.
- ▶ Protecting children is called oppression.
- ▶ When you worship what is not God you lose the ability to think clearly. You lose moral grounding and peace. Constant irrational rage.
- ▶ Every issue becomes an existential crisis.
- ▶ Rational conversations no longer exist because you remove God and there no longer exists meaning and reason.



## **Prophecy #5: I Will Regather You As A Nation**

**Deuteronomy 4:30** “When you are in tribulation, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, you will return to the Lord your God and obey his voice. For the Lord your God is a merciful God. He will not leave you or destroy you or forget the covenant with your fathers that he swore to them.”

**Deuteronomy 30:1-10** “And when all these things come upon you, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before you, and you call them to mind among all the nations where the Lord your God has driven you, and return to the Lord your God, you and your children, and obey his voice in all that I command you today, with all your heart and with all your soul, then the Lord your God will restore your fortunes and have mercy on you, and he will gather you again from all the peoples where the Lord your God has scattered you. If your outcasts are in the uttermost parts of heaven, from there the Lord your God will gather you, and from there he will take you. And the Lord your God will bring you into the land that your fathers possessed, that you may possess it. And he will make you more prosperous and numerous than your fathers. And the Lord your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your offspring, so that you will love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.

And the Lord your God will put all these curses on your foes and enemies who persecuted you. And you shall again obey the voice of the Lord and keep all his commandments that I command you today. The Lord your God will make you abundantly prosperous in all the work of your hand, in the fruit of your womb and in the fruit of your cattle and in the fruit of your ground. For the Lord will again take delight in prospering you, as he took delight in your fathers, when you obey the voice of the Lord your God, to keep his commandments and his statutes that are written in this Book of the Law, when you turn to the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul.”

- ▶ The Jewish nation had disappeared for almost 1900 years then God brought them back. The language was restored.

**Isaiah 66:8** “Who has heard such a thing? Who has seen such things? Shall a land be born in one day? Shall a nation be brought forth in one moment? For as soon as Zion was in labor she brought forth her children.”

**Deuteronomy 30:2** “...and return to the Lord your God, you and your children, and obey his voice in all that I command you today, with all your heart and with all your soul.”



- ▶ The climax, the end of the age.
- ▶ Moses is directing this prophecy to the 2nd generation.

### **3 Critical Observations**

1. In tribulation-Tsar Tsar, meaning narrow place, a place of distress, anguish, claustrophobic, indicating no escape, Jacob used this word when he wrestled with God. Israel used it to describe their slavery in Egypt. The prophets used it to describe the end of the age tribulation.

**Deuteronomy 4:30** “When you are in tribulation, and all these things come upon you in the latter days, you will return to the Lord your God and obey his voice.”

2. And all these things find you, not some but all. Every prophecy, every warning, every blessing and every curse.

**Deuteronomy 30:1** “And when all these things come upon you,...”

3. “In the latter days”—This phrase appears throughout the Bible when referring to the last days.

**Genesis 49:1** “Then Jacob called his sons and said, ‘Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you what shall happen to you in days to come.’”

**Daniel 10:13-14** “The prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me twenty-one days, but Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me, for I was left there with the kings of Persia, and came to make you understand what is to happen to your people in the latter days. For the vision is for days yet to come.”

Prophecy #1: Israel Regathering, Undeniable.

Prophecy #2: Global Moral Corruption

Prophecy #3: The Prophet Like Moses, Yeshua

Prophecy #4: The Nations In Rage.

Prophecy #5: Birth Pangs Triggering Final Tribulation

Conclusion, Moses is prophesying that all these things will be realized at the end, the latter days, from dispersion to the regathering. Apostasy and tribulation.
