4. The last point of the sermon emphasized a God focus on behalf of One Another. We want fellow Christians to know God better because He is their greatest good. Write a list of the people who matter most to you. Think about what you want most for them. Does it match what God wants most for them? Begin praying for them according to the end of Ephesians to know God's peace, love, faith, and grace.
