Faith

Overview

Faith (pistis) is found in 1 Co. 12:9, 13:2. The key here is "the above normal" aspect of faith. All believers are to live and walk by faith, faith is also a part of the fruit of the Spirit. This faith sees beyond obstacles and distractions that would hinder the work of the local church.

NOTE: Some believe that this gift has ceased because it is found in a list of temporary sign gifts.

Characteristics / Indicators of the Gift

- 1. The ability to trust the promises of God in a remarkable way.
- 2. Absolute trust in communication with God.
- 3. The ability to encourage other believers in their personal faith.
- 4. Points out the work of God in order to encourage the faith of others.
- 5. The ability to discern how the Lord is moving.
- 6. Helps to correct a lack of faith in the body.
- 7. Sees the potential of God's will.
- 8. Helps confirm God's desirous will for the local church.
- 9. Points out the provisions of God for the church.
- 10. Sees how God will be glorified in all that He does.

Areas of service

Encourages other believers during difficult times. This person would be a great fit for a missions or building committee. Would help to provide future vision for the church.

Potential Dangers

- 1. A lack of patience with those whose faith is weak.
- 2. Recklessness in decision making (assuming).
- 3. A tendency to get "ahead" of God.
