GOD'S ROLE IN SALVATION

- I. God the Father The Architect
 - A. The Father originated the plan of salvation prior to Creation
 - 1. Christ was foreknown before the foundation of the world 1 Pe. 1:19-20
 - 2. Christ is the Lamb that was slain as from the foundation of the world Rev. 13:8
 - B. Election God's choosing outside of time
 - 1. Election *eklegomai* "in the Middle voice, 'to choose for oneself,' not necessarily implying the rejection of what is not chosen, but 'choosing' with the subsidiary ideas of kindness or favor or love" Vine's
 - a) Believers have been chosen in Christ Eph. 1:4
 - b) Paul's knowledge that these believers were chosen and beloved encourages his communication to the Father 1 Th. 1:4
 - c) Paul expresses gratitude for these believers because God had chosen to salvation from a quality of a beginning 2 Th. 2:13
 - d) God's choosing of individuals to salvation out from the nations is distinct from His choosing of Israel in the OT 1 Peter 2:9
 - 2. The need to balance Election with Man's Free Will
 - a) Christ' death was for all men Jo. 3:16
 - b) God desires that all might be saved 1 Ti. 2:4
 - c) God did not determine that any should perish 2 Pe. 3:9
 - d) God's choosing is never on the basis of one's worth or superiority, it is all of grace (1) OT: Israel Deu. 7:6-8
 - (2) NT: Church 2 Ti. 1:9
 - C. Calling God's calling to salvation in time
 - 1. Called kletos "called, invited" Vine's
 - a) Jo. 6:44 The Father is responsible for drawing one to Christ (drawing: *helko* -"The word does not imply force, still less irresistible force, but merely attraction of some kind, some inducement to come" Cambridge Bible for Schools and Colleges)
 - b) 1 Cor. 1:9 The faithful God called believers to share together with God the Son
 - c) Gal. 1:15 At the exact right time, God called Paul by His grace to salvation
 - d) 1 Th. 2:12 believers have been called unto God's kingdom and glory
 - e) 2 Ti. 1:9 believers have been invited to be set apart
 - D. God saves according to His mercy Tit. 3:5
 - 1. Mercy: *eleos* "kindness or good will towards the miserable and the afflicted, joined with a desire to help them" Outline of Biblical Usage
 - E. God made us alive together with Christ Eph. 2:5, 8
