#### **Exhortation**

### **Overview**

Exhortation (parakeleo) Ro. 12:8, is the ability to encourage or admonish believers so that they will accomplish an activity or an appropriate action. Sometimes acting as a counselor to encourage spiritual growth.

# **Characteristics / Indicators of the Gift**

- 1. Counseling and encouragement is accompanied by a spirit of hope.
- 2. The ability to communicate clearly with people.
- 3. The ability to discern when others are in need of the gift.
- 4. Sees and understands the consequences of carnality.
- 5. Sees the potential in the lives of believers.
- 6. Approaches people as individuals and uses the best approach for each individual.
- 7. Encourages the use of spiritual gifts.
- 8. Encourages consistent spiritual growth and involvement in ministry.
- 9. Ability to analyze problems and tasks for the best solution.
- 10. Not afraid to get involved with the lives of people.

### **Areas of Service**

This gift would function good on a leadership committee, building committee or benevolence. It doesn't necessarily need to be a part of a committee or leadership. The exhorter needs to be around people and sensitive to their needs.

### **Potential Dangers**

- 1. Falling into the trap of becoming a people "fixer."
- 2. Taking pride in successes.
- 3. Becoming discouraged when people do not respond as desired.

4. Spending too much time with those who want attention and not help.
