

## Agape vs Phileo

- Agape (110x in NT) Love sometimes translated charity. A love that seeks to do what is best for the loved one. A love of choice, not based in the beauty or desirability of the object. An unselfish love that esteems others as more important than self, and is ready to serve.
- It is produced by the Holy Spirit in the believer- Gal 5.
- The love believers are to have for each other.
- This love is perfectly expressed in Christ, Eph 2:4
- <u>Phileo</u>-(22x in NT) A tender love of affection, kindness, more emotional. Often described as a family love. Proper phileo seems to grow from agape.

- Jn. 3:16 God's love(agape) for the world, Jn. 16:27 God's love for (phileo) for those who are saved from the world.
- Jn. 3:35, Gods agape for the Son, Jn. 5:20 God's phileo for the Son.
- These uses give us a complete picture of the love of God, a love that we can live out through the finished work of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
