Agape vs Phileo

- **Agape**- (110x in NT) Love sometimes translated charity. A love that seeks to do what is best for the loved one. A love of choice, not based in the beauty or desirability of the object. An unselfish love that esteems others as more important than self, and is ready to serve.

It is produced by the Holy Spirit in the believer- Gal 5.

- The love believers are to have for each other.
- This love is perfectly expressed in Christ, Eph 2:4
- **Phileo**-(22x in NT) A tender love of affection, kindness, more emotional. Often described as a family love. Proper phileo seems to grow from agape.

- Jn. 3:16 God's love(agape) for the world, Jn. 16:27 God's love for (phileo) for those who are saved from the world.
- Jn. 3:35, Gods agape for the Son, Jn. 5:20 God's phileo for the Son.
- These uses give us a complete picture of the love of God, a love that we can live out through the finished work of Jesus and the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives.
