

## THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Today we will continue looking at the lives of people that we find in scripture who were, "*Beautifully Broken*." So far, we have looked at Moses, who made a decision in a moment of heated anger that would forever change the course and direction of his life. However, God was not done with him. After being in exile for forty years, God called him to lead the people of Israel out of slavery.

Next, we considered the life of Joseph. Through no fault of his own, he is sold into slavery, thrown into prison, and let down by those who should have helped him. In spite of it all, Joseph chose to maintain his integrity and to continue to honor God. In the end, God exalted him to a place of leadership that allowed him to save a generation of people.



Last week, we looked at the lives of Ruth and Naomi. These two ladies experienced devastating loses that left them both as widows. Ruth chose to honor God and Naomi by making a commitment to Naomi that could have come at great personal cost. However, God once again honored their faithfulness and redeemed their story. We see the name of Ruth appear in the lineage of Jesus Christ.


